JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 13th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Jericho and Ramallah • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30 and again at 01:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents after storming several merchant shops and confiscated surveillance camera footage and then stormed another home. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents. (iii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Biddu village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents. (v) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village , fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation including Narmeen Mahmoud Shamasneh (5 years old){A patient ill with cancer} leaving her hospitalized. (vi) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal Junction in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii)At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Medical Sector:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Qutna village temporarily seized an Ambulance owned by Qutna village Council and assaulted the Ambulance driver: Hassan Al-Khawaba as he was on duty transporting the patient Narmeen Mahmoud Shamasneh (5 years old){A patient ill with cancer} who suffocated from tear gas inhalation after Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident during confrontations near the wall gate entrance of the village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 15:00, a demonstration took place in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighborhood protesting against the Israeli authority decision to demolish resident's homes and demanding the return of dead resident's corpses to the families. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 5th 2015, Israeli closed the main road connecting silwad and in Yabroud village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al Nabi Saleh village then searched residents and vehicles until 17:30. 2) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet and detained a resident and confiscated their vehicle then withdrew at 17:30. 3) At 15:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Sinya then searched residents and vehicles until 17:30. 4) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Kafr Malik village junction then searched residents and vehicles until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u>

- 1) At 13:15, Israeli Police forces raided Bir Ziet as they were apprehending Bakri Adib Bakri {A resident of Jaljouliya}{A Brazilian Citizen} then temporarily detained him then released him at 13:50.
- 2) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, occupied a home owned by Abdo Abed located near “Pesagout” settlement and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 14:50.
- 3) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound)for alleged stoning and as a result injured 11 residents: Abdel-Rahman Yacoub Hussien, Mohammad Raed Qndil, Mohammad Husam Nassar Musa, Fadi Faysal Hamad, Ala Mohammad Rabi’, Mohammad Abdel-Nasser Abu Kwiek , Tarik Muwafaq Abu Shaqra, Ali Ziyad Abu Waza, Mohammad Hamoud Turkman and Nabil Yasser Ahmad Ammar..
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” Settlement in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Eyad Fahed Nu’man Karakra and Mohammad Ali Karakra {injured}.
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Budrous village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Musa mustafa Musa Al-Asmar (17 years old)..
- (iv) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Abboud fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Ibrahim Sharif abu Hassan(15 years old), abdallah ahmad Saleh (16 years old) and Wajdi Salah Abdel-Majid.
- (v) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Husam Safi.
- (vii) At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Ofar” military base/ Prison fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Liqya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- 1) Israeli forces positioned near Atarah Bridge located in North Bir Ziet detained Ali Sa’id Hussien Al-qam [a resident of Qalandiya camp in Jerusalem}.
- 2) Israeli forces detained Rashed Samih Jabarin in Ramallah.
- 3) Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout settlement located in east Al-Bireh city detained Mohammad Ali Karakra.

- **Demonstrations:**

- (i) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: At 16:55, Israeli forces raided Turat Al-Gharbiya village, clashed with several residents, temporarily seized an Ambulance, searched it and assaulted its driver Saed Al-Atrash and as a result, left him hospitalized with head injuries and then detained two residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Anas NIhad Rafiq Qubha and RIyad Hillal Qubha in Turat Al-Gharbiya village • Settler Violence: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the area located between Kafr Ra'I and "Movo Dotan" settlement then withdrew at 13:00. <p>Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</p>
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 11:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighborhood in Tulkarem. 2) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Far'oun village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:35. 3) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Zibad village until 01:50. • Injury: At 21:00, Taysir Adnan Jun'a Abu Ghaloush {A resident of Al-Baqa Al-Sharqiya village} was hospitalized with injuries after Israeli forces assaulted him near the green Line. • Attack: At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (644) located in Al-Shweikiya neighborhood in Tulkarem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in west Jayyous fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<p>(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated Nitham Ahmad Jamous Nazal (a taxi cab driver) from tear gas inhalation.</p> <p>(iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 37 residents including: Hanadi Mohammad Ziyad (16 years old), Mahmoud Abdel-Rahman Thiyab, Rabi Arafa Adnan Rabi, Mohammad Abu Samara and Ameer Abu Hamad as well as leaving 182 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) At 12:10, a demonstration took place demanding that the Israeli authority to hand over the corpses of residents killed to their families for burial. 2) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) Since 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction then searched residents and vehicles until 14:10. 2) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in north Huwara and prevented residents and vehicles from traveling along the by pass road leading to Jit village junction in qalqiliya 3) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up at Beita junction then searched residents and vehicles. 4) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jama’in then searched residents and vehicles until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, stormed several home, temporarily detained 6 residents: Ayman Fakhri Adli, Fakhri Khaled Adli, abdel-Rahman Sami Adli, Abdel-Rahim Sami Adeli, Nidal Shawkat Adeli, Muhanad Shawkat Adeli and released them at a later time then withdrew at 03:15.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned along the bypass road near “Yitasahar” settlement temporarily detained Al-Mu’tadsim billah Naser mahmoudal-Khatib, Billal Ibrahim Awad, AbdelRaheem Ibrahim Shan’a then released them later. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned near Osirin village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 17:00. 2) At 18:45, Israeli forces raided alZawiya. 3) At 21: 30, Israeli forces raided kafr Al-Dik, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:05. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:55, Israeli forces positioned at Za’ tara checkpoint detained three residents: Mohammad Ayoub Mphammad Ali, Billal Mohammad Zuhier Anab and Wael Khaled Ali Quqa. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the north entrance of Salfit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, Israeli settlers positioned near “Yaq’ir” settlement located in west Deir Istiya stoned residents and vehicles traveling along Wadi Qana road which connects Salfit and Qalqiliya and as result damaged a vehicle owned by Malik Mahmoud Hilmi Talib {A resident of Deir Istiya}.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
 - (x) At 11:00 on November 19th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Za'tara and Al-Fradis village with dirt mound.
 - (xi) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah with dirt mounds.,
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khader Bridge and near Aqbat Hasna area located along the main road, connecting the west village of Bethlehem then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem.
 - (iii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (iv) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Nihalin village then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (v) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Husan village then searched residents and vehicles until 15:00.

- (vi) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur then searched residents and vehicles until 15:20.
- (vii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jurat Al-Sham'a village then searched residents and vehicles until 17:25.
- (viii) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Khadr then searched residents and vehicles then
- (ix) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles until 21:30.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 10:00.
- (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, stormed and searched 3 homes after blasting open the front entrance of a home owned by Adel Hamdan Al-Khatib (as his family was present inside the house) and summoned Salamh Jamal Suliman Shantiya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 05:30.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, in Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem and in Um Al-Rakaba in Al-Khader fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents and left 32 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned in Um Al-Rakaba area located in Al-Khader fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured and left 10 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and then occupied Mahmoud Ha6mdan Al-Wahish's home and converted its rooftop into a Military post then withdrew at 16:40.
- (iii) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Taqou' fired 1 live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents: (of them known are the following): Moath Ibrahim Al-Amour and then occupied 2 homes owned by Jamil Musa Al-Amour and Salim Musa Al-Amour and converted their rooftops into Military posts then withdrew at 17:00.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
 - (viii) Since 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Sima village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
 - (ix) Since November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilat Al-Miya and Al-Dirat villages as well as the bypass road leading to Yatta with dirt mounds.
 - (x) Since 14:00 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance to Eats Yatta.
 - (xi) At 15:00, on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Al-Thahriya.
 - (xii) At 14:00 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Obada, Beit Mara, Deir Al-Asal, Deir Razeh and Karama villages with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 09:00, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints at the north entrance of Hebron, Al-Nabi Yunis area junction and Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Halhoul, Ras Al-Jurah area in Hebron and installed two checkpoints in front of the local Police station in Halhoul and in Ras Al-Jura area and then confiscated a resident's vehicle and placed steel barriers between them and the residents.
 - (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several residents and stormed "Hebron" Radio station, damaged equipment in the station and confiscated broadcast equipment and served military order to close the radio station for a period of 6 months, detained 7 residents then withdrew at 04:20.

- (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed the home of Alaa Musa Za'ariq after breaking open the front entrance and confiscated three cellular telephones.
- (iv) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and confiscated surveillance camera tapes from a merchant shop owned by bMir'I Al-Sharha.
- (v) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir , stormed and searched several homes and detained two residents.
- (vi) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched several homes and detained two residents.
- (vii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village , stormed several homes and detained three residents.
- (viii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Aroub camp, stormed two homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00.
- (ix) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh town and detained a resident.

- (i) On November 20th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron detained Alaa Atef Al-Awwadeh (16 years old).

- (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Abed Darwish Jaradat and Samaha Jamal Hussien Qawazra in Sa'ir.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Nael Mohammad Al-Haroub and Ahmad Munif Hamdan Qazaz in Dura.
- (v) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Abdel-Qadder Al-Haroub, Adam Arafat Odah Al-Haroub and Riyadh Mahmoud Hussien Al-Haroub in Deir Samit.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Basil Yacoub Abdel-Rahman Al-Badawi in Al-Aroub camp.
- (vii) Israeli forces detained Nael Mohamad Haroun Al-Halayqeh in Al-Shiyoukh.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Awwa fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Halhoul bridge, Ras Al-Jura area located in North Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 58 residents including 3 children and 2 children: Alaa Raed M,azar'a (13 years old), Ismail Mahmoud Abu Rayan (17 years old), Mohammad Khaled Karaja (17 years old), Shadi Yusef Zamar'a (A journalist), , Muhanad Hisham Al-Sharif (A journalist), Mohammad Abdel-Nasser Sbatin (A journalist), Hussien Mohammad Allan, Annan Yusef Zamar'a, Mohammad Mahmoud Al-Sa'di, Tamer Khaled Al-Jundi, Jallal Yusef Barqan, Jihad Nabeel Abu Assab, Asef Mahmoud Abu Rayan, Mahmoud Khaled Al-Wah'sh, Malik Basil Ishaq and Abbas Fayad Salah.
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Ummar fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel-Kareem Awad
