<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 02:00 on November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Biddu, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and a chicken farm, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:45.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Suriq village, stormed a home then withdrew at 16:10.</li> <li>(iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident after storming a home.</li> <li>(iv) At 05:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained three residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:30 and again at 14:55, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:55 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Ram, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (v) On November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata, near Shu'fat checkpoint, in Al-Suwana and Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (x) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Amin Sanduqa (a resident of Beit Hanina) and Mahmoud Al-Hadarah (A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 05:00 on November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Dr. Amin Akarai (A University professor) after storming his home in Shu'fat neighbourhood.
- (iii) At dawn on November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Haytham Al-Abbassi and Mohammad Salaymeh in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood.
- (iv) At 09:40, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ali Laban, Hamad Sayad and Mohammad Huwayed in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
- (v) On the morning of November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained Mo'ayad Haykal.
- (vi) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Ibrahim Al-Natsheh (A resident of Qalandiya) for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Mukabir neighbourhood detained two residents including a child: Ehab Ja'diya and Jamal Abu Jamal.
- (viii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained two residents: Fathi Jabr and Murad Al-Ish'hab.
- (ix) Israeli forces detained Hisham Awad in Biddu.
- (x) Israeli forces detained Diy'a Al-Anati in Anata.
- (xi) Israeli forces detained three residents: Saber Obied, Haytham Mahmoud and Rami Darwish in Al-Eisawiya.

- **Physical Assault:** On November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint assaulted Rujieb Mutier (A resident of Qalandiya camp) and as a result, left him hospitalised with a broken arm and contusions.
- **Land Confiscation:** On November 6<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces issued a Military order for the confiscation of 60 (Dumanes/ acres) in Al-Shiekh Assad village for the purpose of settlement expansion
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers and Israeli forces prevented residents under the age of 45 from entering the compound for prayer.
- **Settlement Activity:** On November 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, \*Israeli Authorities approved the

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
