• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the bridge leading to Bir Nabalah.
- **Raid:** On the afternoon of September 1st 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli force detained four residents: Mahmoud Salah Al-Hadaarah, Khalil Al-Jayyusi, Abdallah Al-Hadarah and Tariq Al-Alami.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and prevented several residents from entering the compound.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Container checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, temporarily detained two residents and released them at 13:40.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area in Beit Sahur.

• Raid:

- (i) At 09:40 on September1st 2014, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village damaged the main entrance of a livestock barracks as they searched it then withdrew at 11:00.
- (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained a residents as they stormed a home.
- (iii)At dawn on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashaydeh village, stormed several homes, and detained two residents after assaulting them.

• Detention:

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Ahmad Ibrahim Za'oul (A resident of Hussan) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mashour Shaher Saber Dariya and Ali Fou'ad Dariya in Beit Fajjar as they were reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Diya' Za'oul in Hussan.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained one residents: Salamah Hisham Rashaydeh and Layth Rashaydeh in Al-Rashaydeh village.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces levelled a plot of agricultural land in Irtas village then withdrew at 13:40.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Raid:

- (i) On September 1st 2014, Israeli force raided Yatta and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (ii) On the evening of September 1st 2014, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Huwarah village located in South Al-Thahriya, demolished four homes, three livestock barracks and three bathrooms owned by Suliman Hamad Jabarin, Rateb Mohammad Al-Amour and Ayman Salim Al-Tal for allegedly being built without a licence.
- (iii)At 01:40 and again at 06:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a livestock barracks and demolished the barracks for allegedly being built without a licence.

Detention:

- (i) At 23:20 on August 31st 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Muhanad Ahmad Al-Barbarawi (17 years old) and Mahmoud Muqbil (17 years old) as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp detained Yusef Riyad Mahmoud Gayth (A resident of Beit Ummar).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Issa Jabarin in Yatta.
- <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of September 1st 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thaher area located in Beit Ummar near "Karmi Tsur" settelemnt fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area between 100 to 300 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.
