JERUSALEM	 Closure: Since January 13th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem. Raid: At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Mikhmas village, stormed a home and detained a resident. Detention: On the evening of January 20th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Qara'in and Ahmad Siyam for photographing Israeli troops as they assaulted the minor Imad Sharaha. - (iii) Israeli forces detained Yousef Al-Alamy (17 years) and Mohammad Khalil during their raid into Beit Ummar.
- Attack: At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas gernades towards several minors for alleged stoning.
- <u>Injury:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces detonated a UFX in Yatta, injuring 2 minors, Loya Ruba'i (11 years) and Islam Ruba'i (13 years); they were taken to an Israeli hospital.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:05, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to sabotage a mosque located between Beit Ummar and Urub camp.
- <u>Demonstrations</u>: At 11:45, residents marched after Friday prayers in protest to against settler violence, settlement activity and the prevention of Palestinian farmers from accessing their agricultural land.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire by launching 2 missiles towards Rafah
