- (i) On January 19<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Mohammad Amr, a resident of Beit Ur Al-Tahta village in Ramallah as he was travelling to Jordan.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Ahmad Daraghmeh as he was travelling to Jordan.
- (iii) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamra checkpoint detained Amar Dabiyat.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

#### <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 05:00 on January 20<sup>th</sup> 2014 and again at 11:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 11:45.
- (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:40.

#### Detention:

(i) Israeli forces detained Fawzi Sarhan in Al-Ubeidiya.

### BETHLEHEM

- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Thawabteh in Beit Fajjar.
- Physical Assault: At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned in north Beit Jallah assaulted 2 residents: Saleh Abu Hamed (a resident of Al-Ayada camp) and Raed Fanun (a resident of Hebron) leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- Settler Violence: On January 20<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers installed several mobile homes in Al-Nahla area located in Wadi Rahal village in an attempt to create a settlement outpost.

#### **Wall Construction:**

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area...

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

# (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

Flying Checkpoint: At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction.

- (i) At dawn on January 20<sup>th</sup> 2014. Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and demolished 2 sheds owned by Salemat Abu Zaneed and Khalil Al-Hurub for allegedly being built without a licence.
- (iii)At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa, clashed with several residents as they demolished a shed and concrete fence surrounding a home owned by Sufyan Masalmeh for allegedly being built without a licence then detained a resident.
- (iv) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im.
- (v) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Sinjir area located between Hebron and Dura, stormed and searched a home then detained a resident.
- (vi) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 05:45.

# **HEBRON**

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Salamiya in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mu'taz Masalmeh in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Ashraf Al-Turki in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained Hufaytha Ramadan in raided Sinjir area located between Hebron and Dura.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near "Adawar" settlement in west Hebron opened fire towards Firas Sakour, a resident of Tarqumiya and as result left him hospitalised with gunshot wounds.
- (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 19:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained Islam Abu Hamadiya (11 years old) as he was near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron then released him at a later time.
- Assault on Property: At 08:50, Israeli forces prevented several residents and farmers from reaching their agricultural land located in Um Al-Khier village which is located near "Karamil" settlement in east Yatta, temporarily detained 5 residents including 2 children and 2 women: Omar Al-Hathalin (17 years old), Husam Al-Hathalin (16 years old), Tarik Al-Hathalin, Maliha Al-Hathalin and Bakhita Al-Hathalin then released them at a later time.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

## ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line and detonating a UXO near Israeli military vehicles near the border fence.

### NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Attack: At 09:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in Beit Lahiya, temporarily detained 2 fishermen including a child: Ahmad Abu Warda (17 years old) and Yusef Abu Warda, confiscated their fishing boat which is owned by Raed Abu Warda then released them near. Beit Hanun (Erez) crossing at 24:00.
