(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. 	<p>Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <p>(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</p> <p>(iii) At 09:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and served demolition orders for an apartment and a home owned by Sammer Al-Isawi and his brother. (iii) At dawn on January 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Yazan Al-Rajjabi (14 years old) and Mohammad Gayth (15 years old) after storming their home in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli positioned near Al-Ram junction fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(iii) Israeli forces detained Anas Al-Auri (16 years old) in raided Beit Ur Al-Tahta. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At dawn on January 22nd 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Sinjil and stole 800 Olive grove plants planted on approximately 200 dunumes (acres) provided from funding by the International Red Cross Society. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:40, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Al-Bireh city in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed a home and summoned Lu'ay Haniya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 09:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Kafr Qaddum temporarily detained Mus'ab Amer then released him at 14:15. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:40 intensified its restrictions and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq village junction. (iii) At 13:05, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village and took photographs of several homes then withdrew at 13:30. (iv) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Burin village, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:15. (v) At dawn on January 22nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Ein Beit Al-Ma camp, stormed a home and detained a resident in the camp. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli force detained Majed Hamayel in Beita. (ii) At 18:05, Israeli forces raided Betar village, stormed several homes then withdrew at 19:05. (iii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village and stormed several homes. (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Shawarat village, stormed several homes then withdrew at 04:40. • <u>Injury:</u> At 14:05, Abed Houmarat was injured after his vehicle collided with an Israeli Police vehicle as he was travelling near the entrance of Husan village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Al-Azraq leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction,

the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

- (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction.

- (iv) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Huwar area junction located near the north entrance of Halhul.
- (v) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
- (vi) At 07:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Tarqumiya and Ithna junctions.

- **Raid:** At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident after storming his home.

- (i) At 03:30 on January 21st 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Murad Abu Raqaba and his brother during their raid into Al-Thahriya.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Oday Al-Ja'bari in Hebron.

- **Settler Violence:** At 11:20, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Suissa village located on south Yatta, installed barbed wire fence around 20 dunums of agricultural land owned by Al-Da'janaeh and Al-Hillis families in an attempt to confiscate it.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
