JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in A-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jib village, stormed Hamza Matrouks home (The alleged attacker who stabbed several Israeli settlers in Tel Aviv) and confiscated a computer then withdrew at 13:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sa’aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces detained Shadi Ghadda (A resident of Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood). (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Eid in Beit Hanina. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli Forces Temporary detained two women near Bab Al Selesleh gate leading to Aqsa Mosque, preventing them from entering to pray. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the morning of January 21st 2015, Israeli forces stormed Shu’fat neighbourhood and demolished a building consisting of four apartments owned by Mukhmir, Al-Mishni and Bisharah families for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:35. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road, which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 18:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and its camps, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Haytham Kharowish and Yunis Matroq in Tulkarem and its camps. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained several family members of Hamza Matrouks (The alleged attacker who stabbed several Israeli settlers in Tel Aviv) then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. (ii) At 19:25, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 19:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Immatin village, stormed two homes, confiscated a computer from Khaled Ghanams home then withdrew at 01:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp, stormed and searched two homes then withdrew at 01:45. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinatah until 11:20. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Jabal Al-Najlah area located near Irtas village until 12:00. (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Khalayel Al-Louz until 13:30. (iii) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Taqou', opened fire towards several children for allegedly stoning an Israeli settler's vehicle. (iv) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village until 22:30. (v) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, confiscated an agricultural tractor then withdrew at 03:05. • Attack: At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 19:00, an Israeli settler opened fire towards several residents near the entrance of Taqou' then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Awwa junction until 11:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and positioned in front Palestinian Civil Defence Headquarters. (ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Wadi Sud area located between Tafuh and Dura. (iii) At 14:35, Israeli forces raided Shoyoukh Al-Aroub village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:10. (iv) At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp. (v) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Jurat Al-Jamal area in Yatta. (vi) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched four homes, detained a child then withdrew at 04:10. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yasser Masharqa (17 years old) in Dura. • <u>Attack:</u> On January 21st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thaer area located in Beit Ummar and near "Karmi Tsur" settlement, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats in North Gaza and Rafah and as a result injured a Palestinian fisherman.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, medical patients, students , residents holding entry permits and diplomats and residents holding foreign passports (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
