	• Assault on Places of Worship: On the morning of January 22 <sup>nd</sup> 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection Of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosques compound and provoked worshiper during which Israeli forces detained a student in one of the mosques religious teachings center as he protested the settlers assaults.
	• Detention:  (i) At dawn on January 23 <sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces detained 3 children: Majdi Abu Tayeh (13 years old), Alaa Abu Tayeh (14 years old) and Munthir Al-Abbasi 15 years old) as they stormed their homes in Ein Al-Louza area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and Israeli forces summoned Mahdi Thiyab( 14 years old) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
	(ii) Israeli forces detained Alaa Al-Hija during their raid into Al-Aqsa Mosque compound.
	• <u>Demonstration</u> : On January 22 <sup>nd</sup> 2013, a demonstration took place near the Municipality building in Jerusalem protesting the decisions to pave a road (4) on land in Beit Safafa village which connects several settlement blocks to east Jerusalem.

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Rafah.
