JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several University students near Abu Dis University during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several students and as a result left several of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also assaulted and injured a student as they detained him and installed a barbed wire fence along the main road near the University entrance then withdrew at 14:50. (ii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed and searched a home, detained a child, confiscated a computer then withdrew at 04:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15 on January 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Hussein Attita (14 years old) in Al-Isawiya village as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Rami Abu Al-Hawa (17 years old) in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mu'taz Bdr in Abu Dis. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ragheb Jabr (16 years old) in Al-Eizariya. • <u>Obstruction of Medical Sector:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned at Hizma checkpoint and temporarily seized a truck carrying medical supplies to the Palestinian Red Crescent Society then allowed it to pass through at a later time. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Liqya until 16:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on January 22nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Rantis village and detained a resident after storming his home. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al-Tahta village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 21:45. (iii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:10. (iv) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Jihad Wahdan in Rantis village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Jihad Rashid in Bir Zeit. (iii) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Sa'afin in Beituniya.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamun, set up a checkpoint at its entrance until 12:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Al-Hamra” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic during which they temporarily detained 4 residents: Sami Fuqaha, Ghazi Sawafta, Mohammad Abu Mata’ and Firas Sawafta then released them at 13:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Ibziq village, and demolished a home , 2 residential tents and 5 livestock sheds as well as a storage room owned by : Ali Sawafta (A home built from stone and Mud), Mohammad Jabarin (A residential tent and 3 livestock dens), Issa Jabarin (A residential tent , a livestock shed and a storage room) then withdrew at 11:20. (ii) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Khirbit Yarza village and demolished a residential tent and several dens owned by Haytham Daraghmeh (a residential tent and 2 dens), Fayeze Daraghmeh (A residential tent and 2 livestock den) Fawzi Einbus (2 livestock dens), Khaled Daraghmeh (a livestock den and a livestock feeding tray), Na’im Masa’ed (a livestock den), Hafith Masa’id (a livestock den), and Sami Daraghme (3 livestock dens and a storage room) then withdrew at 15:00.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Attil. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Zeita, stormed several homes then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Qaddumin” settlement

(iii) At 18/:20, Israeli forces raided Habalat, detained a residents then withdrew at 19:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Abu Khadr in Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hassan Shawahneh in Habalat. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:40 intensified its restrictions and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Aqraba and Beita junctions. (ii) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Dajjan village junction until 11:50. (iii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in north Huwara until 22:45. (iv) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at the entrance of Burin until 01:40.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with its residents and as a result injured Mahmoud Al-Tawil and Mu'ad Khatatba (Fractured foot) and 5 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained Yusef Mahmoud (16 years old) then released him at a later time. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Huwara, imposed a curfew on its residents opened fire then withdrew at 01:30. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed and searched a Turkish bath spa took photographs of the building then withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nassarat in Beit Furiq. • <u>Injury:</u> At 08:40, the child Akram Bani Maniyat (12 years old), a resident of Aqraba was injured after an Israeli UXO exploded near the area he was playing leaving him hospitalised with injuries to his legs. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 residents: Yasser Eid and Haytham Najjar then released them at 16:40. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces demolished a solar panel electrical generator owned by Yassar Jame' for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:45, Israeli settlers set fire to agricultural land in Beit Furiq.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 children: Husni Shamlawi (14 years old) and Hamza Faza' (15 years old) near the main road then released them at 16:30. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces temporarily detained Faraj Al-Haj and his 2 children as they were traveling in their vehicle near "Ariel" settlement then released them at 17:00. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 06:15, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Qana area in Deir Istiya, levelled and uprooted approximately 1000 Olive trees despite being located in a nature reserve area, during which they fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the levelling of the land which is owned by Abdel Karim Mansour, Qasem Mansour and Abdel Qadder Abu Hijleh. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and set up a checkpoint. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed several homes, detained 4 residents including a child then withdrew at 04:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:25, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem detained Jihad Ibiyat (17 years old), a resident of Al-Ubidiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Yusef Thaewabteh (17 years old), Ismail Dara'ya, Nael Thawabteh and Nabil Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Beit Fajjar temporarily detained 6 children and 2 residents then released them at 15:00.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents inside the camp for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
