JERUSALEM	 Closure: Since January 6th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by firing 5 tank shells towards Gaza and Israeli jets launched 4 missiles towards north Gaza and Khan Younis.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Raid: On the morning of January 23rd 2012, Israeli forces escorting several bulldozers raided Beit Lahia and levelled a plot of agricultural land. Attack: At 08:30, Israeli forces fired 2 artillery shells towards Beit Hanoun. At 12:05, Israeli forces fired 4 artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beit Lahia. Aerial Assault: At 01:00, Israeli jets fired 3 missiles towards agricultural land in Beit Lahia.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Khan Younis	 <u>Aerial Assault:</u> At 01:15, Israeli jets fired 3 missiles towards agricultural land in Khan Younis. <u>Killing:</u> On January 23rd 2012, Ahmad Suweil died after suffering from injuries sustained in 2002.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas,7 truckloads of wheat , 20 imported vehicles, and construction material for internationally funded projects. Al Awda crossing – Rafah was open for the exit of patients, students and passengers with permits.

Detainees Update

• An Israeli military court in Ofar prison sentenced Motasim Raqban, a resident of Bethlehem to an additional 22-month prison sentence and a 4000 NIS fine (approximately 1060 USD).
