#### **WEST BANK**

## • Closure:

- (i) On January 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from other Districts from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces closed Wadi Al-Hilweh road in Silwan neighbourhood and impeded the free flow of traffic.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Demonstration:** At 12:45, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented residents from reaching the demonstration site clashed with Israeli forces during which Israeli forces temporarily detained: Hussien Barijah and Yusef Abu Mariya.

## • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 15:25.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge, temporarily detained Hani Abu Rayan (A resident of Halhul) then n released him after interrogation by Israeli intelligence officers after taking him to "Kiryat Arba" "settlement.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya until 15:50.
- (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 03:25.

#### Detention:

- (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar detained the child Yazen Akhlil (17 years old).
- (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained four children: Hijazi Id'ies (16 years old), Amjad Irfa'iya (16 years old), Muhanad Idris (17 years old) and Hisham Darwish (16 years old).
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned near Sweisiya village temporarily detained two residents: Wissam Arafeh and Muntasir Shakhtour as they were attempting to plant Olive trees on land which is under threat of confiscation then released them later.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 12:50, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military assaulted several residents as they were planting Olive trees on their land in Al-Sweissa village in east Yatta.

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured a resident.
- Israeli Naval vessel broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.
