JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 24th 2014, Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Sheikh Jarrar neighbourhood in Jerusalem protesting against home confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlers and settlement construction in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south

RAMALLAH &AL-BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sinya village junction. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil. (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh until 20:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed an apartment building and summoned 2 residents" Ibrahim Abu Al-Rub and Husam Eliyan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Silwad fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned at "Ofar" fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp , fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured the child Mahmoud Hamad (16 years old) after being struck with a tear gas grenade canister to his abdomen leaving him hospitalised . • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:35, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road near Um Safa village. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators, injured 2 residents: Nimr Taha and Wael Burnat and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction, demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 23:50. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nazlat Al-Gharbiya village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces detained Mu'tasim Jaroushi as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence based on a prior summon. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 17:30 and again at 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (iii) At 17:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village and temporarily detained Husam Dahoud (A Palestinian intelligence officer) then released him at 22:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators, injured 2 residents including a journalist: Jafar Ishtayeh and Mohammad Barham after being struck with tear gas grenade canisters and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation as well as temporarily detaining Hassan Al-Ghafer then released him at 16:30. (ii) At 14:00, a demonstration took place near Izbit Al-Tabib village protesting against land confiscation, settlement construction and uprooting Olive trees for the purpose of settlement expansion and at 15:00 Israeli forces stormed the area and uprooted Olive trees that were planted. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic and closed gate the wall and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>

	<p>(i) Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.</p>
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:45, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 11:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus and clashed with several residents until 04:15. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near "Yitmar" settlement in Beit Furiq fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:30, Israeli settlers stormed Beit Furiq under the protection of Israeli forces that fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Deir Istiya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and occupied the rooftop of a home owned by Yasser Abu Zied then withdrew at 12:40. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Harris village. (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya until 01:40. (iv) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Bidya, summoned Abdel Hakim Ibrahim to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:35. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 09:55, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nu'emeh village until 11:55.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Za'tara. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on January 25th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Container checkpoint detained Mohammad Abu Akel , a resident of Al-Samou'. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near Bilal Bin Rabah mosque in north Bethlehem fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'asra village protesting against the construction of the wall and against the prevention of protestors from reaching the demonstration site during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards residents and as a result left several of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town due to

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp. (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hahul bridge. (iii) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area in north Hebron. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp. • Attack: At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Khier area in Yatta, levelled agricultural land owned by Halima Al-Hathalin and Suliman Al-Hathalin during which Israeli forces assaulted Maliha Al-Hathalin as she attempted to prevent the settler attack leaving her hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli settlers positioned along the main road connecting Dura and Beit Awa stoned residents and vehicles. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result killed a resident and injured 3 others. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shored of North Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of January 24th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents as they attempted to climb the border fence and as a result killed a resident and injured 3 others. (ii) On the evening of January 24th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya and detained 2 fishermen and destroyed their fishing boat. (iii) At dawn on January 25th 2014, 4, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Billal Awayda in Jabaliya. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 unidentified residents in Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
