JERUSALEM	Closure:  (i) Since January 6 <sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.  Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. #### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

#### Checkpoints:

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 17:50 on 16 January, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint for some time, impeding the free flow of traffic.

Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road (i) east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. Since 14:30, on January 10<sup>th</sup>2012, Israeli forces closed the road leading to (ii) several homes in Kirbet Al Dir near Tak'o with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoint: At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Tagou. Raid: At 06:00 on January 25<sup>th</sup> 2012 Israeli forces raided Hussan village, stormed (i) several homes and detained 2 residents. At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Tagou and detained 3 residents, including 2 (ii) minors, then withdrew at 04:15. **Detention:** As mentioned in the previous report at 01:10 on January 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli (i) forces detained Munir Ikhmeis, Mohammad Ikhmeis and Ahmad Dawud during their raid into Bethlehem. Israeli forces detained Mohammad Manassra and Mohammad Ayash during (ii) their raid into Husan village. Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Kawazba (17 years), Gharib Al-Kawazba (iii) (17 years) and Nasim Al-Kawazba. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. Hebron The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village. Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar (v) Since 09:40 on January 10<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army has closed the entrance of (vi) Beit Amra village with cement blocks.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint in Wadi Qabun area north of Hebron City.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint in Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Kheir village east of Yatta and demolished 2 barracks owned by Yasser Abed Al-Hathalin and Suliman Abed Al-Hathalin.
- (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Deirat village and demolished a home under construction owned by Abed Al-Imour.
- (iv) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Rifa'iyya village east of Yatta, prevented Mohammad Ibrahim from repairing his home and forced him to sign an affidavit pledging not to conduct any repair work on his home. Israeli forces also confiscated farming equipment and assaulted Mohammad Abu Qubtiya when he tryied to prevent Israeli soldiers from confiscating his equipment; he sustained minor injuries.
- (v) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Tarqumia and searched a home.
- (vi) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou and detained 2 residents.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces fired flash and teargas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Hani Ashour. Israeli forces also assaulted Mohammad Abu Sbeih during his detention; he was also interrogated.

#### • Detention:

- (i) On the morning of January 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Kahel detained Mohammad Hawamda.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Majdi Jibril during their raid into Al-Samou.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark.
