JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
 - (iii) On the morning of January 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Ram with cement blocks
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata junction and detained a resident
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 06:00 on January 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Bakr Al-Mughrabi in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
 - (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata junction detained Mohammad Mahmoud (A resident of Anata).
- **Temporary Detention:** On the afternoon on January 26th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqsa mosque compound temporarily detained three residents: Hanadi Al-Saqa, Ikhlas Ruo’oud and Hanan Anu Snieneh.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Mohammad Awayda (10 years old) then released him later.
- **Home Demolition:** On January 26th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Sur Bahar village and served a demolition order for a home owned by Musa Amerah for allegedly being built without a licence.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
