JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 26th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and detained 2 residents (A Resident and a woman accompanied by a 1 month old infant). (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Anata and summoned 2 residents: Yusef Hamdan and Ahmad Aliyan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and Abu Dis, stormed several homes and detained 15 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on January 28th 2014, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Baha Abu Al-Hawa, Tarik Abu Al-Hawa and Waleed Abu Al-Hawa in Jabal Al-Tur Neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rantis village for alleged firebombing of vehicles. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> On the morning of January 28th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh temporarily seized a vehicle carrying Palestinian Prime Minister for a period of 45 min as he was travelling from Nablus and inspected his security cards Identification Cards then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:05, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Maythaloun, Al-Zibabda, Antara, Siris, Al-Jidadeh and Sir Villages. (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya, stormed several homes and detained 2 residents including a University student. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hussni Awidat and Naji Nazal in Qabatiya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 12:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and set up a checkpoint. (ii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Zeita and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Abu Hamdi and Mohammad Samara in Zieta. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib. (iii) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Jayuss. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 12:10, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land located in Al-Qa'da area in Beit Furiq under the protection of Israeli forces who opened fire and launched tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settlers attack and as a result injured Hammam Hani after falling to the ground while being apprehended by Israeli forces leaving him hospitalised with a broken arm.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya and set up a checkpoint. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 15:50. (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and set up a checkpoint. (iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem and detained a resident. (v) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Irtas village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Basel Milhim in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Raid: At 08:40, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 150 m into the vicinity of Beit Hanun and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land.
