### **WEST BANK**

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On the morning of January 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Ram with cement blocks

## • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- Raid: At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou', occupied Nayef Suliman and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 14:00.

### • Detention:

- (i) At 02:15 on January 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Ammer during their raid into Bethlehem as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Abdel-Karim Abu Sneineh (17 years old) {A resident of Hebron}.
- (iii)At 21:05, Israeli forces detained Wurud Farajat (A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp in Jericho) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning in "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement based on a prior summon.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Al-Ayda camp temporarily detained Issa Al-Aq (13 years old) for alleged stoning then released him at 14:30.

## • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction,

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Othman Al-Hashlamoun (17 years old){A resident of Hebron}for allegedly carrying a knife then released him at a later time.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Al-Taban village located in east Yatta and served a military order for the demolition of a a residential barracks and a livestock barracks owned by Samir Mahdmah and Nasser Abu Obied as well as removing several electric Solar panels owned by Khaled Al-Amour.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:00, Israeli settlers from "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron assaulted Najah Da'nah.
- Land Confiscation: On January 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces served as Military order for the confiscation of 5000 dunumes (Acres) of land located near the wall gate in Beit Ullah owned by Osama Nasseir, Farid Al-Alamah, Ahmad Al-Alamah, Ahmad Alamah, Hamdi Alamah, Harbi Alamah, Mohammad Abdel-Aziz Alamah, Issa Alamah and Faris Al-lamah, and declared the land State property.
