JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u>

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic until 17:00.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Safafa village, summoned Mohammad Eliyan , Qayse Eliyan, Diya Othman and Salah Barakat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Malee Adumin” settlement junction.
- **Raids:** At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed a home and detained a resident.
- **Expulsion:** On January 28th 2013, Israeli authorities authorized the expulsion of Abdallah Alqam, Secretary General of Jerusalem and Palestinian tribes who resides in Shufat camp for a period of 30 days and imposed a financial penalty of 5000 NIS approximately 1350 USD.
- **Home Demolition:** At 08:00, Israeli forces demolished a portion of a home consisting of a room with aluminium roof which is owned by Faraj Shqier, demolished a parking garage and barracks, levelled a plot of land while demolishing a home entrance , stair case and uprooted several trees owned by Abdel Min’im Shikawi as well as levelling plot of land and uprooting several olive trees owned by Ahmad Sumrien in Silwan neighbourhood, during which resident protesting the demolitions clashed with Israeli forces who fired stun and tear gas grenades towards them and as a result injured Sa’da Skqier in the foot and Badriya Abu Snieneh (85 years old) suffocated from tear gas inhalation. Israeli forces also unleashed police dogs towards as they detained 4 residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained Musa Matar in Al-Izariya.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Faris Sumrien , Khalid Al-Zir, Sami Shqier and Ali Shqier in Silwan neighbourhood
- **Temporary Detention:** At 15:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Abdel Salam Salah Al-Din in front of his home in Hizma village
- **Land Levelling:** At 11:00, Israeli forces levelled an area near the vicinity of A-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 09:00, Israeli forces escorting a group of Israeli settlers in the presence of Israeli police stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshipers.
- **Demonstration:**
 - (i) At 16:00, a demonstration took place in front of the Municipality building in Jerusalem protesting the planned construction of a road on land in Beit Safafa village to connecting Israeli settlement with Jerusalem
 - (ii) At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Abu Dis in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Settler Violence: At 01:00, Israeli settlers stormed Beitin village, attacked Fayez Hamads home then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. • Demonstration: At 12/; 40, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Al-Bireh city in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Jamala village and Arran. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Mughier village, stormed 16 homes (6 of which are for Palestinian Security Forces), detained its residents including 6 Palestinian Security force officers and released them after taking photographs of their homes, identification cards and recorded their cellular phone numbers. (ii) At dawn on January 29th 2013, Israeli forces raided Abba village, searched a home and detained a University student. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Saber Azamta in Abba village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area. • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near " Migoula" settlement in the Jordan valley. • Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Thaghra village in Tubas, stormed 7 homes, detained, interrogated and recorded cellular phone numbers of 7 residents: Jihad Abdel Raziq, Riyad Abdel Raziq, Hassan Abu Muhisan, Ahmad Abu Muhisan, Abdel Min'im Abu Muhisan, Abdel Raouf Muhisan and Raouf Jamal. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Iyad Al-Insawi in the Jordan Valley. • Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in Tubas in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of

	<p>traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, temporarily detained several University guards as they were positioned at the University entrance and released them at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> At 01:00 on January 28th 2013, Israeli forces detained Amid Ashour as they raided Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Odeh , a resident of Kafr Thulth in Azzun • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Qalqiliya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Aqraba, demolished 2 barracks and a water tank owned by Bassem Jabr and Ahmad Hamdan. (ii) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Burin village and clashed with its residents.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho, served a demolition order for a home owned by Nidal Biliyat for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of its location in area C and gave him 3 days to leave his home and summoned Hassan Taha and Yusef Abbas to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 11:45. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village and forced several Sheppard's off agricultural land. (iii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Sultan camp in Jericho, searched a home and shops, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ghassan Al-Razim in Ein Al- Sultan camp in Jericho. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Humra checkpoint temporarily detained Mahdi Assous, National Security Officer and released him at 16:45. (ii) On January 28th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge prevented Nihaya Mohammad, the Deputy of the Woman Association, from leaving to Jordan and detained her. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 16:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli, forces raided Ayda camp in Bethlehem until 12:00. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Faradis and searched a home. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem fired tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in a funeral for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in the vicinity of the Nativity church in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzyq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Qaboun area in north Hebron until 09:10. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. .
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
