	Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;			
	and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 17:20, the Israeli army increased restrictions on "Shave Shomron" (iii) checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. At 18:00, the Israeli army increased its restrictions on "Huwara" (iv) checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 08:10and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Burin (i) village iunction. (ii) At 10:20 and again at 07:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction. At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beita village junction. (iii) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Maslakh area (iv) junction. At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement (v) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint Beita junction. (vi) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction. (vii) Raids: (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Iraq Burin village. At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Qabalan and detained 3 minors for alleged (ii) stoning then released them at 20:20. At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Burin. (iii) **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two (i) detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to (ii) Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of Since January 23<sup>rd</sup> 2012. Israeli forces continue to close the bypass road (iii) leading to Burgin with dirt mounds. **SALFIT** Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at the Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Hares village, served 4 home demolition orders to Saber Daoud, Fares Daoud, Yasser Kleib and Ahmad Ssouf for allegedly being built without proper licensing then withdrew at 10:45(the structures are located in Area C, which is under Israeli military and administrative control). Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for the Sabbath holiday.

#### Hebron

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks.
- (vi) Since January 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Tel Al Rumayda neighbourhood in the Old City of Hebron.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Halhoul bridge.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Karantina area in the Old City of Hebron.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a flying checkpoint.
- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Dura town and fired teargas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed a home and summoned Ahmad Al Jayawi to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched several homes and detained 3 residents, including 2 minors.

#### • **Detention:**

- (i) At dawn on January 29<sup>th</sup>2012, Israeli forces detained Farid Al-Arouri in the Old City of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Hamza Awad (17 years), Moayad Jaber (17 years) and Moath Al-Qam.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:30, a group of Israeli settlers stoned homes in Tel Al Rumayda neighbourhood in the Old Ccity of Hebron
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
