JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

(ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, detained 4 residents including a woman and temporarily detained 3 others then released them at a later time. (iii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Hanin Abu Al-Humus, Mohammad Abu Al-Hummus, Mohammad Ahmad Abu Al-Hummus and Abdallah Abu Al-Hummus in Al-Isawiya. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Beit Safafa village, surrounded 3 homes and 3 residential dens owned by Salah families then withdrew at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Qarwat Bani Zied and Kafr Ein villages. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge. (iii) At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Illu village junction. (ii) At 12:35 and again at 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Qusay Barackat (13 years old) and Tamer Nimer. (iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned at Atara bridge fired rubber coated steel

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Jaba', stormed several homes, detained 5 residents then withdrew at 05:25. (ii) At dawn on January 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Bruqin, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Mahran Fashafsheh, Kamel Alawneh, Tarik Alawneh, Rami Alawneh and Wahib Alawneh in Jaba'. (ii) Israeli forces detained Suheib Jarrar in Bruqin. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:10, Israeli settlers stormed the previously abandoned settlement of Homish then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided in Tulkarem until 11:05. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Far'un village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents near the wall gate. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

(iv) At 07:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jib village junction. • Raid: At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib, stormed a demonstration tent placed on a plot of land which is under threat of confiscation and stormed 2 homes • Attack: At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 19:45. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and level a plot of land in the local cemetery then withdrew at 12:50. (iv) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Ein Shabli village until 02:54. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 9 residents: Baha Ishtawi, Samir Hashash, Shaker Hashash, Omar Miskawi, Mohammad Abu Dara’, Ali Arouj, Ahmad Nassar, Ahmad Dajani and Mohammad Abadi in Nablus, Askar and Balata camps. • Settler Violence: On January 29th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Madma village and damaged the limbs of 25 Olive trees owned by Anwar Nassar.

(ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 16:00. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Nihalin and Al-Jab'a village junctions until 18:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Asakra village temporarily detained 2 children: Mohammad Asakra (14 years old) and Mu'taz Asakra (16 years old) then released them at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces detained 4 residents including a child: Yusef Al-Zir (17 years old), Ayoun Al-Zir, Mohammad Al-Zir and Salim Al-Zir as they were reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. • <u>Settler Violence:, At</u> 15:50 An Israeli settler opened fire from his vehicle as he stormed Taqou' then withdrew at 16:15. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
