<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Anata. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on January 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained Fayez Duwiat in Sur Bahar village. (ii) At dawn on January 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mahdi Al-Rashq in Al-Eizariya. (iii) At dawn on January 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained Ammar Abu Maliya in Ras Al Almoud neighbourhood. (iv) On the morning of January 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained Injud Mutier (A resident of Jerusalem) as he was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (v) At 14:00, Israeli forces detained Ayman Abu Sneneh in the old city of Jerusalem. (vi) At 20:50, Israeli forces detained Saqer Al-Abiedi (A resident of Bethlehem) in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram north junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Zied, searched a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village detained Imad Khalil (A resident of Kafr Ain village). (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Rashid in Qarwat Bani Zied village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:45 on January 28th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Ofar” settlement dumped waste onto residential land in Silwad.

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road in Huwara until 12:50. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:45 and again at 23:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 00:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jihad Khaled in Deir Istiya.

(ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ain Dweik village located in North Jericho. • <u>00:20</u> • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:10 and again at, Israeli forces raided Jericho, temporarily detained 3 residents: Aladdin Eid, Mohammad Salah and Ismail Imeleh then released them later and withdrew at 01:25.

Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-' Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed a home and detained a woman. (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed a home and summoned Muthfir Al-Manoura to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained two residents including a child: Oday Jaber (15 years old) and Shadi Jaber. (ii) Israeli forces detained Lubna Al-Khatib in Yatta. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Samah Abu Sneineh then released him at 15:40. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained three residents including two children: Amad Al-Natsheh (16 years old), Suhayeb Al-Afghani (17 years old) and Kamal Al-Natsheh then released them at 01:25. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of January 29th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thaheer area located in Beit Ummar located near "Karmi Tsur" settlement fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. Detention: On the evening of January 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel
