#### **Closure of Roads:** (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second *Intifada*, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al Nabi Eliyas village. (ii) (iii) At 22:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Hija village. Raids: At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Al Nabi Eliyas village, temporarily detained (i) several residents for allegedly stoning a settler vehicle and detained another At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home, summoned Ahmad (ii) Abu Haniya to Israeli intelligence for questioning, set up a flying checkpoint, temporarily detained and interrogated several residents and withdrew at 16:10. At 15:15 and again at 02:25, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya, searched 2 homes (iii) and withdrew at 05:00. At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Oaddum, searched several homes and (iv) **QALQILYA** detained 4 residents including an intelligence officer. (i) Israeli forces detained Wael Khalaf during their raid into Al-Nabi Eliyas Israeli forces detained Majdi Obeid (an intelligence officer), Abdel Latif (ii) Obeid, Oqba Obeid and Ali Jumaa during their raid into Kafr Qaddum. (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Lagef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

#### Closure of Main Roads:

#### Hebron

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 09:40 on 10.01.2012, Israeli forces continued closing the entrance of Beit Amra with concrete blocks.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron and searched several homes.
- (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and Dura.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 23:05, Israeli forces detained Ghassan Al-Tamimi, Bassam Al-Tamimi and Suhaib Al-Tamimi in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the Old City of Hebron.
- **Settlement Activity:** On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces levelled 15 dunums of land near "Karmel" settlement for the purpose of settlement expansion.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 13:15, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to abduct Ali Hathalin in Yatta but they were prevented by local residents.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, family members of detainees rallied in front of International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with detainees and to demand their release from Israeli prisons.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by firing tank artillery shells towards Central Gaza and Rafah.

RAFAH	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points:         <ul> <li>Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critical patients, students and residents with special permits</li> <li>Sufa Crossing is closed.</li> <li>Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, cooking gas. 38 truckloads of livestock feed, construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects and 1 shipment of strawberries were allowed through.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Raid: On January 30th 2012, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided Al-Dihniya area in Rafah and detained 2 residents including a minor.</li> <li>Detention: Israeli forces detained Hajaj Al-Sufy (17 years) and Ahmad Abu Athreh.</li> </ul>
