JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and stormed an Athletic center and several merchant shops. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Jabal area in Abu Dis fired live ammunition and rubber coated steel bullets and as a result injured 2 residents including a child as they detained them. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several

	<p>children for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iii) At dawn on January 31st 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za'im checkpoint in east Jerusalem opened fire towards Nasser Juhar and as a result injured him.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Adam Halbiya (17 years old) and Juher Halbiya in Abu Dis. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 12:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:05, Israeli forces raided Ein Yabrud and Bitien. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces detained Nidal Batanji, a resident of Al-Jalazun camp as he was reporting to "Bet El" to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) On January 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained Hamada Wahdan, a resident of Rantis village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:05, Israeli forces positioned in front of Ofar prison fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on January 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Maythaloun, clashed with several residents as they stormed a coffee shop and 2 homes and summoned Tawfoq Raba'ya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Siris village, stormed and searched a home. (iv) At 04:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun until 07:25.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid until 11:00. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli air force broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles during 5 consecutive air strikes towards North Gaza, Gaza and Rafah and as a result injured 7 residents including 3 children. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
