JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya and detained a resident in Abu Dis. (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, stormed several homes summoned 6 residents: Shadi Awad (A National Security Officer), Mahmoud Awad, Mohammad Awad, Isail Awad, Hani Awad and Jihad Zied to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Adham Antar in Abu Dis. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of June 30th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Abu Mash'al junction, detained 2 residents, temporarily detained 2 resident: Shadad Zahran and Foad Zahran and released them at a later time. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Yabrud village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Zahran and Hamza Al-Barghouthi at Deir Abu Mashal junction. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Yamoun. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zababda. • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces confiscated a truck owned by Issam Bani Odeh, which was carrying 4 residential tents being delivered to several Beiduin families whose homes were demolished by Israeli forces in Khursa village near the Jordan Valley. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 3 rooms in Bardala village owned by Tamer Sawafta, Jihad Sawafta and Mohammad Sawfta.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Izbet Shufa village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed 2 homes and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sa’ed Awad and Nayef Abu Al-Hala in Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, assaulted Ahmad Khdeir, a resident of Nablus and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jayyus, • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, set up several checkpoints at its entrance and prevented residents from entering or exiting. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:20, Israeli settlers stormed Azzun, assaulted Omar Al-Madaniya, a resident of Kafr Laqif and as result left him injured with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched several homes and detained 2 residents. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided the area between Iraq Burin and Tel villages. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Sabustiya village. (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Huwara, stormed several homes, a detained a resident (Head of a village council) and confiscated 2 hunting rifles. (v) At dawn on July 1st 2013, Israeli forces raided Beita and stormed several homes • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Aref Al-Safadi in Orif village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Nasser Mufdi (Haed of the Village council). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli settlers stormed Einabus village, set fire to several acres of agricultural land and as a result destroyed 50 Olive trees before Palestinian Civil Defence forces could extinguish the flames. (ii) At 18:20, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village, set fire to agricultural land during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the assault and as a result left 2 residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On June 23rd 2013, Israeli forces served confiscation orders for the confiscation of 80 dunumes (acres) of land in Awrata and Rujieb village for military purposes.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya . (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Shqier and Samer Shqier in Al-Zawiya. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area

	<p>in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 11:45. (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr, temporarily detained Walid Al-Amari (13 years old) and released him at a later time then withdrew at 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Taqou 'and fired flash grenades. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al Azat camp in Bethlehem, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident, assaulted 3 residents: Sadil Al-Izza , Nidal Al-Iza and Khadr Al-Izza leaving them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Izza in Al-Azzat camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge until 09:50.
 - (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints on roads 35 &60 located in North Hebron and at Beit Anun junction.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Ras Al-Wad area in Sa'ir, served a demolition order to demolish Yusef Al-Jabarins home for allegedly being built without licencing.
 - (ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident.
 - (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Safa village, stormed and searched several homes and detained 3 residents including 2 children.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained Thaer Abu Sanad in Dura.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Sayf Abu Daya (17 years old), Hassan Khalil (16 years old) and Mahmoud Khalil.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and allowed 20 truckloads of humanitarian goods.
