JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers during which confrontations erupted between several worshippers and Israeli settlers and Israeli forces detained a resident. (ii) At 00:40. Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in order prevent residents from repelling settler assault planned during afternoon prayers. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Bakriyat in Sur Bahar village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khalil Al-Abadi (A student at Al-Aqsa mosque Islamic school) inside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:15, Israeli settler positioned at “Jivat Za’if” settlement stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Biddu and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Amin Marrar. (ii) At 02:20, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Beit Hanina and attempted to kidnap the wife of Rami Zaloum as well as his 10 year old son (Both residents of Shu’fat) and assaulted them during which local residents succeeded in preventing the kidnapping and left the victims hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Surda junction until 01:50. (ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 00:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Sudan village until 02:55. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El “ settlement junction stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp during which Israeli forces stormed the area and closed the road thus impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Rantis village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 03:00

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Annin village, opened fire and launched flash grenades in the area located between Anin village and Al-Taybeh then withdrew at 01:15. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result killed a resident and detained 3 others. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Yusef Abu Zaghat in Jenin Camp. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ahmad Al-Nursi, Yusef Shabrawi and Yazan Al-Damj in Jenin camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:30, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles as well as stoning Hatem Salah’s home and damaged a Green House during which they withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village until 01:40. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli settlers stormed the entrance of Kafr Thulth then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. At 01:40. (ii) At 02:40, Israeli settlers positioned near “Qadumim” settlement stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road and as a result damaged a rental vehicle driven by Ayman Al-Jada’ • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: At 06:50, Israeli forces raided Talluza village until 07:10.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to tw9 detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 23:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 24:00. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near road (90) junction located in Al-New'meh village at the north entrance of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:40 on June 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Beit Jallah with steal gates.
- (x) At 18:30, Israeli forces closed all entrances and by pass roads leading to the main road din Al-Ubeidiya.
 - **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located at the south entrance of Jericho.
 - (ii) At 04:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za’tara until 06:30.
 - (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 06:30.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At 04:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha, stormed and searched several homes, merchant shops and vehicle repair shops, confiscated surveillance tapes then stormed and searched a “Consumer Institution” after blasting open the front entrance using explosives, temporarily detained 3 residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 07:00.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Diya’ Shusheh in Husan village.
 - **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) At 22:30, Israeli settlers positioned at “Kafar Itsiyon” settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron.
 - (ii) At 00:15, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Sanabil Al-Tus (9 years old) along the main road leading to Jaba’ and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions.
 - (iii) At 02:30, Israeli settlers stoned residents located in Wadi Al-Baqr area located between Nahhalin and Husan.
 - **Wall Construction:**
 - (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
 - (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
 - (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
- **Closure:**

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Halhul, surveyed and mapped agricultural land and searched several water wells where the bodies of the 3 missing Israeli settlers were discovered during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents.
 - (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, closed all the entrances leading to the city with several checkpoints, clashed with several residents in Ras Al-Jura area and near Hebron University and as a result injured Rushdi Urushid (16 years old), then stormed the homes and destroyed the front entrances of the homes of Marwan Al-Qawasmeh and Amar Abu Eisheh {The alleged kidnappers of the 3 Israeli settlers according to the Israeli Military} and as a result injured the infant Bara' Al-Qawasmeh (3 months old) and Shaymeh Al-Qawasmeh with head injuries as a result of shattered glass from the explosions then stormed and searched several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 02:00.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 03:10 on June 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Imad Al-Qawasmeh, Majed Al-Qawasmeh and Abbas Al-Natsheh during their raid into Hebron.
 - (ii) On the evening of June 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained Sajjed Sultan after being assaulted by Israeli forces as he was attempting to prevent a group of armed Israeli settlers from attacking his home in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained Yahya Nassr Al-Din and Hani Al-Zaghier in Hebron.
- **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) On June 29th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Wadi Abu Rish area located in Beit Ummar and chopped down 15 Olive trees owned by Hamad Al-Salibi.
 - (ii) At 21:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Beit Ummar, during which Israeli forces opened fire towards residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured 4 residents

	<p>including 2 children: Muhab Aadi (17 years old), Sayef Akhlil (17 years old), Baha Za'ariq and Baha Akhlil leaving them hospitalised.</p> <p>(iii) At 22:50, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles in the old city of Hebron during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured Ibrahim Aboudi leaving him hospitalised with head injuries after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the head.</p> <p>(iv) At 23:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured Ashraf Idris near the old city of Hebron leaving him hospitalised with contusions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire and launching missiles towards North Gaza. • Israeli fighter Jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 34 consecutive strikes towards 11 areas in North Gaza, Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result injured 4 residents in Khan Yunis. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 16 projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Authorities).

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed.
