JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ village junction.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu until 04:50.
- **Killing:** At 06:00, the corpse of Mohammad Abu Khdeir (16 years old){A resident of Shu’fat neighbourhood} was found Burnt and killed in Deir Yassin village after Israeli settlers abducted him as he was leaving his home for dawn prayers at a local mosque in Shu’fat {As confirmed by several witnesses and surveillance recordings during the morning of July 2nd 2014} during which several residents protested the abduction and killing then clashed with Israeli forces who injured 12 residents including 3 journalists: Kristien Rinawi (Palestine Television Reporter), Ali Yassin (A photographer) and Ahmad Gharabeh (A journalist) and Israeli forces closed the main entrance leading to the neighbourhood.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 03:50, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which confrontations erupted between several worshipers and Israeli forces and as a result injured 2 residents.
- **Home Demolition:** On July 1st 2014, Israeli forces served a demolition order to demolish a home owned by Ass’ad Shamasneh for allegedly being built without a

	<p>proper licence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, a group of Israeli settlers installed several tents in E1 area located in east Jerusalem in an attempt to confiscate it and establish a settlement outpost. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem and assaulted an unidentified woman as she was in her vehicle while waiting at a traffic light and shattered the windshield of her vehicle and as a result was hospitalised with contusions. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli settler positioned near Al-Jadid and Al-Khalil gate in Jerusalem stoned residents and vehicles during which several residents clashed with the settlers as they attempted to prevent the assault. (iv) At 01:45, Israeli settlers positioned near “Kokhav Yocoub” settlement assaulted Elisa’s Lutfi (A resident of Shu’fat) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. (v) At 02:45, Israeli settler attacked “Abu Sbieh” supermarket then clashed with several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack during which Israeli forces detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:35, Israeli forces detained 3 residents {from Beit Fajjar in Bethlehem}: Majdi Taqatqa, Nizar Taqatqa and Eyad Taqatqa in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Yahya Salamin in Anata. (iii) Israeli forces detained Misbah Abu Sbieh in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie’ and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni’meh • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, detained a journalist and served a demolition order to demolish Abbas Qur’an’s home then withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Mughier village, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:10. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Deir Ghassaneh, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:00. (iv) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:10.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya , detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:50. (iii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents as the stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured 5 residents: Bajes Qayed (A National Security Force officer), Yassir Al-Sayed, Mohammad Al-Qut, Harris Abu Hussien, and Mahmoud Al-Lahlouh and damaged home furniture owned by Fathi Al-Atoum (A National Security Force officer), detained 3 residents then withdrew at 07:00. (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Yahya Al-Zayoud and Hussein Jarradat in Al-Silah Al-Harhiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Saleh Al-Sa’di, Fatfi Al-Ghanoum and Anas Al-Ghanoum in Jenin. (iii) Israeli forces detained Nassim Zayed in Al-Yamoun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Immatin village junction until 17:45. (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of “Qadumim” settlement along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Immatin village until 02:45. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:30, Israeli settlers closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus then reopened it and withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 20:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

(iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Nablus, Balata, Asqar and Ein Beit Al-Ma' camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and merchant shops after detonating a merchant shop door owned by Nasser Muheisien and as a result injured 3 residents: Amid Shalabi, Jallal Qaddumi and Mahmoud Mir'I leaving them hospitalised with contusions and Israeli forces damaged a Palestinian Civil defence force fire truck and detained 7 residents and summoned Ahmad Hajj Ali (A PLC member) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Aqraba, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:00. (v) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Nassariya village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Omar Darawsheh in Talouza village. (ii) Israeli forces detained 7 residents :Abdallah Al-Iker, Sameh Al-Asmar, Annan Bushkar, Yahya Nassr Al-Din, Omar Abu Khamis , Ahmad Doulat and Ehab Al-Kilani in Nablus, Balata, Asqar and Ein Beit Al-Ma' camps. (iii) Israeli forces detained Omar Midama and Omar Khater in Aqraba village. (iv) Israeli forces detained Khalid Massa'ied in Al-Nasiriya village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli settlers stormed Aqraba , set fire to a livestock barracks, sprayed racist Graffiti on walls, during which residents were able to rescue a herd of sheep owned by Fadi Jaber from the fire. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli settlers stormed Kafr Qalil and climbed onto the rooftop of Farid Mansours home then withdrew at 04:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Harris village until 12:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Marda village until 20:50. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Oja village until 12:05. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:30, Israeli settlers stormed road (90) near Al-Fasayil village and stoned several residents and vehicles and as a result shattered the windshield of a vehicle owned by Nassar Abu Jaysh (A resident of Nablus).
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to

 - (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a Car selling lot owned by Daher Al-Tarda , confiscated surveillance footage then at 01:35 stormed and searched several homes and merchant shops and also stormed a Charity organization, confiscated several equipment and files and detained 5 residents.
 - (iii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained 3 residents.
 - (iv) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Ithna, closed all the main entrances with checkpoints thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the area, clashed with several residents after detonating and damaging the main entrance of Ziyads Awads home and as a result injured 12 residents including 4 children : Ahmad Salaymeh (13 years old), Mohammad Salaymeh (14 years old), Mahmoud Awardeh (16 years old) Shadi Al-Najjar (17 year sold), Bilal Al-Tumayzi, Kathim Al-Najjar, Hazim Al-Najjar, Mohammad Farkhallah, Ismail Atiya, Qusay Al-Tumayzi, Fadi Al-Jowawi and Mu'taz Salaymeh leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
 - (v) At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Nuba and Beit Ulla.
 - (vi) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya and stormed and searched a home.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Fathi Al-Joulani, Muntheir Al-Jub'a, Jawad Al-Qaraq, Qayed Al-Atwaneh and Billal Al-Muhtasib in Hebron.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Riziq Al-Rujub, Ahmad Al-Qiq and Jamal Al-Awadeh in Dura.
 - **Temporary Detention:** At 22:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Hisham Idris Mohammad Idris (15 years old) and Mus'ab Idris after storming their home in the old city of Hebron and also temporarily detained Yusef Id'eis then released them at 23:10.
 - **Attack:** At 03:20, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Zayed School in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Land Levelling:** At 11:45, Israeli forces stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and levelled a plot of land owned by Al-Natsheh Family.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
