JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound except for Women, Permit holders and emergency cases. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 18:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces detained Tamer Al-Halaqiya in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Osama Abu Nassar, Adham Abu Nassar and Hassan Abu Shahien near Kafr Aqqab village • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On the morning of July 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned

	<p>near Al-Majlis gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained Hanadi Al-Hilwani and Khadija Kahwis then released them after taking them to an Israeli Police station.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned near Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces positioned near Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood and closed off the home of Oday Abu Jamal (A resident killed by Israeli forces during November 18th 2014) with cement blocks and steel. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to “Beit El” settlement with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Yabroud village until 05:00 (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Dibwan until 05:00. (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Um Safa and Deir Al-Sudan villages until 02:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with several residents as the stormed and searched several merchant shops and confiscated several surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 19:30. (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Ain Yabroud village and confiscated several surveillance camera footage from a merchant shop then withdrew at 22:30. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Jerier village, confiscated several surveillance camera footage from a home owned by Farid Alawi then withdrew at 21:30.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Aanza village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Omar in Far’oun village.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village; temporary detained Hikmat Ishtewi (A resident of Kafr Qaddum) then released him at 18:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village and summoned Issam Hanoun to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 14:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village until 00:45. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tel village until 02:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Burqa village until 23:00. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus. (iii) At 07:10, Israeli forces raided Odala village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Atef Rashad in Odala village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:20, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village and set fire to agricultural land during which Palestinian Civil defence forces were able to put out the fire.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 18:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge. (ii) At 23:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafil Harris and Harris village. • Raid: At 23:20, Israeli forces raided Harris village, temporarily detained the child: Mohammad Sultan then released him later. • Settler Violence: At 03:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara checkpoint assaulted four residents including three women: Shifa Abu Sa'da, Jana Abu Yacoub, Wafa Abu Yacoub and Huthayfa Abu Yacoub leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jericho until 21:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt

	<p>mounds.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 14:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and installed checkpoints at its entrance. (ii) On the evening of July 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Husan village and clashed with several residents. (iii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured five residents including a child: Ibrahim Al-Khamour (17 years old), Khalil Abu Laban, Mohammad Al-Sayfi, Raghed Shamroukh and Tuqay Manasra and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Raghed Shamroukh and Waleed Al-Ja'fari in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to closed Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces temporarily detained three residents including a child: Majdi Abu Hashhash (14 years old), Yahya Awad and Abdallah Yaghi. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:30, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron and attacked two homes owned by Shadi Sader and Mahmoud Abu Yahya.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Central Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 07:00 on July 1st 2015, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers stormed 200m into east Deir Al-Balah and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land near the border fence then withdrew at 14:45. • Attack: On the morning of July 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Maghazi camp.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
