## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At dawn on July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and detained a resident after storming his home.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat neighbourhood and Shu’fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting the lynching and murder of the child Mohammad Abu Khdir (16 years old) by Israeli settlers in Shu’fat as mentioned in the previous report and the attacks continued until dawn on July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014 and as a result injured 60 residents including several children then withdrew at 02:00..
  - (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning until 01:20.
  - (iii) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then withdrew at 02:00.
  - (iv) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to a restaurant owned by Al-Salaymeh family and a branch for Jafar Sweets Shop then withdrew at 01:20.
  - (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting the lynching and murder of the child Mohammad Abu Khdir (16 years old) by Israeli settlers in Shu’fat as mentioned in the previous report and as a result injured 4 residents then withdrew at
