JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of

Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 24:00 closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at a later time.

- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up several checkpoint at the entrances of Shu'fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem and Beit Hanina thus preventing residents from entering or leaving the areas.
- (ii) At 01:00 on July 4th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Malee Adumin" settlement junction and impeded the free flow of traffic for the alleged firebombing then reopened it a later time.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya and detained a resident after storming and searching his home.
- (iii) At dawn on July 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Samir Ammis area located in North Jerusalem and detained 2 residents.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting the lynching and murder of the child Mohammad Abu Khdir (16 years old) by Israeli settlers in Shu'fat as mentioned in the previous report
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at near Abu Dis, Al-Eizariya, Beit Hanina, Al-Eisawiya, Sur Bahar, Qalandiya checkpoint, near Al-Ram and Anatta junctions, Shu'fat, Al-Tur, Ras Al-Amoud, Silwan and Suwanah fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents: Amjad Matour (A resident of Qalandiya), Mohammad Salaymeh (A resident of Silwan neighbourhood), Firas Badran (A resident of Qalandiya camp), Fadi Al-Sayad (A resident of Al-Tur) and Ramiz Issa as well as detaining 6 residents including 2 children.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 20:30, Israeli settlers stormed Beit Hanina and attempted to abduct the child Mohammad Al-Kiswani (8 years old) during which residents were able to prevent the abduction during which they were able to flee under the protection of Israeli forces who temporally detained 2 residents as they tried to repel the settler attack.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Khan Al-Humra area and stoned residents and vehicles travelling to Ramallah then withdrew at 01:45.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Dweik in Al-Eizariya.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Midhat Obeid in Al-Isawiya village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Badran Samih Badran and Wassim Baddran in Samir Ammis area located in North Jerusalem.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Karim Abu Khdeir (17 years old), Taha Abu Khdeir (17 years old), Tarik Abu Khdeir, Ammar Al-Fitawi, Mohammad Rab'I and Mu'taz Al-Qam in Jerusalem

- **Wall Gates:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 17:40 on June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya with dirt mounds and cement blocks. (iv) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (v) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Deir Ibbie' and Ras Kar Kar villages and the main road connecting Kafr Ni'meh and Ras Kar Kar villages • Flying Checkpoint: At 01:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illo village. • Land Confiscation: At 10:10, Israeli forces served a Military order for the confiscation of a Plot of land owned by Abbas Al-Wan in Ein Yabrud village for alleged military purposes. • Settler Violence: At 23:20, Israeli settlers stormed Ras Kar Kar and Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya where Palestinian Security forces temporally detained 3 Israeli settlers and returned them to Israeli Authorities. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Arraba and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Fahed Za'rour (A resident of Al-Silah Al-Harhiya) at Arraba junction. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Migoliya" settlement which is located in the North Jordan Valley. • Settler Violence: At 22:10, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Farisiya area in the North Jordan valley and threatened residents to kill residents as they pointed Automatic weapons towards Kahdr Daraghme during which they fled under the protection of Israeli forces.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 02:10, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 03:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Far’aun village until 01:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Fuqin temporarily detained Majed Harasheh (A resident of Fu’qin) then released him at 09:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:00, Israeli settlers positioned along the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa blocked the road and prevented resident or vehicles from travelling along the road. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is prevented to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall then allowed them to pass through at 09:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until until 02:30. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village detained Ehab Al-Sadah (A resident of Azzun). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sabustiya until 17:00.

(iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar “settlement junction located in North Huwrra and impeded the free flow of traffic and prevented vehicles from accessing the bypass road leading to Jit village until 01:30. • Raid: At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed archeological sites then withdrew at 17:00. • Confiscation of Property: At 11:20, Israeli forces confiscated a Bulldozer owned by the Palestinian Public Works and Housing Ministry as it was paving a road between Qusra and “Magdalen “settlement. • Land Confiscation: On July 3rd 2014, Israeli forces served a Military order for the confiscation of 16 dunumes (acres) of land located on Plots (10) and (12) in Al-Naqura and Deir Saharaf villages. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village and levelled plots of agricultural land then withdrew at 14:30. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village and its junctions then withdrew at 02:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: On the evening of July 3rd 2014, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 11:00. • Assault on Property: At 19:15, Israeli forces served a halt to construction order for a home (Under construction) owned by Abdel Bassit Hussien for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under full Israeli Military and Administrative control. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 11:25. Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 13:30. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10 and again at 06:50 on July 4th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 07:30. (ii) At 10:30 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint road (90) near Al-Nu’emeh village located in North Jericho until 12:00. (iii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jiftlik village junction until 12:35. (iv) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Marj Al-Naj’a, Marj Al-Ghazal and Zabidat villages. • Raid: At 09:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and summoned Muslih Maghasleh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • Detention: At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Odeh Jahalin (A resident of Jericho) as he was returning from Jordan.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 09:50.
 - (ii) At 02:45, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah until 05:10.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 22:40 and again at 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents and mapped a plot of land then withdrew at 04:30
 - (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village, stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 23:15.
 - (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Sadr area in Beit Jallah, fired flash grenades into the sky as they searched for residents then withdrew at 04:00.
- **Settlement Activity:**
 - (i) At 21:30, Israeli military bulldozers levelled plots of land in Irtas in order to pave a settlement road to link several settlement outposts then withdrew at 05:00.
 - (ii) At 00:10, Israeli bulldozers levelled approximately 200 dunumes (acres) of land in Khirbeit Iskara village for the purpose of settlement expansion.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place near a checkpoint located near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in north Bethlehem protesting against the abduction and Murder of the Child Mohammad Abu Khdeir by Israeli settlers in Shu'fat during which they clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . (iii) At 22:30 on June 14th 2014, Israeli forces order the closure of all entrances to District of Hebron and announced it was a closed Military area, installed several checkpoints in around the district, prevented residents or vehicles from entering or exiting the entire district including those with entry permits into Israeli and prevented all resident from the district under the age of 50 from travelling through Allenby bridge to Jordan {After 3 Israeli settlers went missing from the area as alleged by The Israeli Military Authorities } • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-' Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
