WEST BANK

 Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. 			
Closure of Main Roads:			
(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.			
(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.			
• Checkpoints:			
 (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to 			

construct the wall.

- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya junction.
- **Raid:** At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with several residents.

Attack:

- (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Navi Ycoub" settlement in Beit Hanina fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting the lynching and murder of the child Mohammad Abu Khdier (16 years old) by Israeli settlers in Shu'fat as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sheik Jarah neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents
- (v) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near the main road leading to Hizma fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and vehicles and as a result injured a resident
- (vi) At 22:35, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint and Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained 3 residents in Al-Ram
- (vii)At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood and Um Tuba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 22:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 00:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and detained a resident for alleged stoning and spraying of pepper spray onto several settlers during which several Israeli settlers opened fire towards resident.
- (x) At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Makassar Hospital in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Injury:</u> Three residents: Ahmad Al-Badari (A journalist), Ahmad Jaber (A Journalist) and Nader Sa'ida were injured during confrontations with Israeli forces in Jerusalem and its neighbourhoods.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Shawiesh in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Anas Al-Qanib, Iz Al-Shweiky and Abdallah Faraj in Al-Ram.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohamad Al-Abbassi in the old city of Jerusalem.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 00:15, Israeli settlers stormed Beit Saffafavillage and stoned several residents and vehicles
- (ii) At 19:35, Israeli settlers positioned near "Malee Adumim" settlement stoned a truck owned by Ahmad Abidoun and Eyad Al-Qawasmi and as a result damaged the truck..
- (iv) At 22:35, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood and stoned residents and vehicles.

• Wall Gates:

July 6th 2014 The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in (i) Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 17:40 on June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya with dirt mounds and cement blocks. (iv) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.

- (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Halmish" settlement stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged 2 vehicles owned by Khalid Shihadeh and Mohammad Shubak during which Israeli settlers attempted to storm Al-Nabi Saleh village but were prevented by several residents during which Israeli forces fired stun grenades towards residents and withdrew at 04:15.
- (iii) At 01:20, Israeli settlers positioned near Attara bridge stoned residents and vehicles then withdrew at 01:30.
- (iv) At dawn on July 6th 2014, Israeli settlers positioned near Deir Abu, Mash'al checkpoint stoned residents and vehicles and as a result hit the vehicle of Attalah Al-Eisawi (A Preist) as he was returning from church and as a result damaged his vehicle and was able to flee from the settlers.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-

- <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces stormed Ein Faris area in Nihalin village s and served a halt to construction order for a home owned by Kamal Al-Nis m Mohammad Al-Niss and Mahmoud Al-Nis for allegedly being built without a licence.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 15:20, Israeli settlers stormed Irtas and chased the child Mohammad Ayash (12 years old) using attack dogs in an attempt to assault and kidnap him (The child was able to flee the attackers) during which the settlers withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
- (ii) At 16:15, Israeli settlers stormed east Taqou' and installed several tents, water and electricity networks in an attempt to confiscate the land and establish a settlement outpost.
- (iii)At 00:45, Israeli settlers stormed Ush Al-Ghurab area in Beit Sahur, stoned several residents and vehicles and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Adel Abu Haniya.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli fighter jets broke the cease-fire agreement by launching missiles in seven consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result injured a resident. Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 20 projectiles towards the Green Line (As Alleged by the Israeli Military Authorities).
