JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint

near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Dur Hay Al-Ras Al-Amoud in Jerusalem.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched Al-Quds University campus then assaulted 2 residents: Mohammad Ariqat and Musa Ayad.
 - (ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and clashed with several residents.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Ghazawneh (17 years old) and Ahmad Allawi.
 - (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned along the main road near Hizma village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Annata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (v) At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Nasser Abu Sneineh.
- **Expulsion:** On July 6th 2014, Israeli courts ruled for the expulsion of the Child Tarik Abu Khdeir (16 years old) (A citizen of the United States of America) from Shu'fat neighbourhood to Beit Hanina for a period of 9 days and imposed a financial penalty of 3000 NIS approximately \$870 as well as a 3rd person financial guarantee of 10000 NIS approximately \$2900 and sentenced him to 9 days house arrest.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 11:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.
- **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) At 22:05, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem and stoned residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) On the evening of July 6th 2014, Israeli settler assaulted and injured Ayman Abu Irmeleh and Yazan Al-Souri.
 - (iii) At dawn on July 6th 2014, Israeli settlers armed with steel pipes stormed Jerusalem and assaulted Mohammad Ayyad (A resident of Hebron) as he was travelling to work and as a result leaving him critically injured.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya

(iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Deir Abu Mash'al village junction assaulted Ibrahim Zahran leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli settlers positioned at the entrance of Ni'ilin assaulted 6 labours as they were heading to work. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli settlers stormed Deir Nathim village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Bireh city, stoned the home of Khaled Assaf and as a result damaged his vehicle then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 02:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:40.

(ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Nazlat Issa village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left 3 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned near Ashour factories in west Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including a child: Aysar Basrallah (17 years old), Samer Mass'I, Mu'taz Abu Libdeh and Ibrahim Abu Sa'deh. • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus detained Muhanad Yassin (A resident of Tulkarem). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:00, Israeli settlers positioned along the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa, temporally abducted a residents then Israeli forces released him at a later time.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 00:10. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 4 homes and assaulted Nassim Mir'I and summoned Mohammad Mir'I to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:25. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Ahmad Khateeb (A journalist) from Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jiftlik village until 22:10 (iii) At 00:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 01:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and stormed and searched several merchant shops. (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:25, Israeli forces positioned at New'meh village junction at the north entrance of Jericho fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 00:55. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah until 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> On the morning of July 6th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint on road (60) which connects Bethlehem and Hebron detained Abdel Majeed Huroub (A resident of Bethlehem). • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fa'hs area located in south Hebron.
 - (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction until 14:40.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Wael Al-Zur (A Journalist) and detained a resident.
 - (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation and assaulted Faq'qa Al-Baddu leaving her injured with contusions.
 - (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (v) At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village junction fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
