JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:30, Israeli force raided Qatna village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 05:00 on July 7th 2013, Israeli forces detained Husam Odeh in the old

	<p>city of Jerusalem.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ayad, a resident of Abu Dis as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</p> <p>(iii) Israeli forces detained Issa Al-Dabari in Qatna village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of July 7th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on July 7th 2013, Israeli forces raided Ni'lin and detained 2 residents. (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Atta Qammas and Mohammad Hijazi in Ni'lin. (ii) Israeli forces detained Fallah Nada in Al-Bireh. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, a demonstration took place in Deir Qaddis village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement expansion, clashed with Israeli forces and as result injured Jamil Barghouthi after a tear gas grenade canister struck him and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Ramallah in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Jalqamus, Um Tut and Deir Abu Da'if villages, set up checkpoints at their entrances then withdrew at 19:15. • <u>Detention:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Rummana village detained Mohammad Abu Hammad after opening fire towards him despite the fact his home is located near the wall gate. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

	special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Khirbit Atuf village and Al-Bouq'a area, took photographs of several water wells owned by Yusef Bashirat then withdrew at 10:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road (connecting Tulkarem and Qalqiliya) until 15:15. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem and detained a resident. (ii) At 07:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem stormed and searched a home, detained a resident and assaulted Daraghmeh Al-Aly and Nabil Abu Tahoun leaving them injured with contusions. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Al-Badawi in Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hassib Al-Ali in Tulkarem. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Azzun and Izbat Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 10:30 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jayyus. (iv) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun Bridge until 22:35. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, clashed with its residents and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Salim in Jayyus. • Settlement Activity: At 08:20, the Israeli Electrical company under the protection of Israeli forces began levelling land in Wadi Qana, uprooted several Olive trees and installed electrical poles on land owned by Abdel Aziz Bashir. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qabalan junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Awarta village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed archeologically sites then withdrew at 05:00. (ii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed Joseph's tomb, clashed with residents as they stormed 4 buildings used as University Dormitories then withdrew at 05:20. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 04:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Huwwara checkpoint in Nablus stoned vehicles near the checkpoint.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south west entrance of Beit Jalla. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on July 7th 2013, Israeli forces raided Betar village, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents and temporarily detained: Ghassan Abu Na'meh and released him after receiving a summon to report to Israeli intelligence. (ii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, stormed and searched 2 homes and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Mu'ammam, Atta Mu'ammam and Bassan Mu'ammam in Betar village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Issa and Mohammad Issa in Al-Khadr. • <u>Installation of Military Post:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near Husan village installed several military caravans onto a plot of land owned by Imad Al-Sha'er. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On July 7th 2013, Israeli settlers pumped sewage waste onto residential land in Wadi Fuqin village and flooded 100 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction

	near Betar village.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Beit Ummar and at the north entrance of Hebron. (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp. (iii) At 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im. (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes and detained 3 residents including a mentally challenged child. (iii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Dura. (iv) At dawn on July 8th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with its residents as they stormed a home and detained 2 residents including a child. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces prevented residents of Um Al-Kier village located in east Yatta from reaching their agricultural land and a water well network located near "Krama'il" settlement and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, Israeli forces detained Tamer Al-Atrash as he was guiding several International tourists in the old city of Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Alaa Abu Ghazi (16 years old) {mentally challenged}, Rabah Al-Fadilat and Yusef Abu Afiya in Al-Urub camp.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At 02:00 on July 7th 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza and damaged a fishing boat owned by Saleh Abu Riyalat.
