JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 6th 2014, Israeli forces detained Amal Othman (A resident of Beit

(iii) At dawn on July 7th 2014, Israeli forces detained 10 residents: Sami Al-Batsh, Ibrahim Al-Boutani, Muhanad Al- Butani, Hamada Al-Mazalmeh, Waleed Al-Rashq, Abdallah Al-Joulani, Ibrahim Al-Joulani, Ashraf Al-Za'tari, Fayez Al-Boutani and Tariq Idris in the old city of Jerusalem. (iv) On July 7th 2014, Israeli forces detained six residents' including four children: Mohammad Aliyan (17 years old), Ahmad Aliyan (17 years old), Jibril Al-Qiswani (17 years old), Bara' Al-Khatib (16 years old), Abdallah Aliyan and Annan Subhi in Beit Safafa and Sharafat villages. (v) On July 7th 2014, Israeli forces detained Anas Yacoub (A resident of Qalandiya camp) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (vi) At 03:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Abdallah Amireh, Mamdouh Al-Qarout and Ahmad Al-Qarut in Sur village. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli Police and Military prevented residents under the age of 35 years from entering Al-Aqsa mosque and closed the main entrance gate leading to the mosque until after noon prayers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of July 6th 2014, Israeli settlers assaulted and injured Abdel-Rahman Abu Dilo in Jerusalem. (ii) On the afternoon of July 7th 2014, an armed Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Mukkabir neighbourhood and opened fire towards several residents inside a merchant shop. (iii) At 19:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound assaulted and injured Nuha Mislieh (A Journalist). (iv) At 00:10, Israeli settlers positioned at "Malee Adumin" settlement junction stoned residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

(iv) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shuqba village until 19:30. (v) At 00:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aboud, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 00:30. (vi) At 00:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Ni'ma village until 01:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:55, Israeli forces raided Silwad until 19:20. (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 04:10. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, clashed with residents as they stormed a home then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Salem Zahran, Ahmad Zahran and Zahran Hassan Zahran in Deir Abu Mash'al village. (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Musa Akram Musa, Amer Abdallah, Mohammad Amjad Shalabi and Mohammad Shaqib Shalabi in Silwad. (iii) Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge in north Bir Zeit detained Yusef Al-Luwil (A national Security force officer). (iv) Israeli forces detained four residents: Ali Abdel Majid, Mohammad Abu Hassan, Osama Dar Saleh and Hussein Abdel Majid in Aboud. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:25, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Kar Kar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent Israeli settlers from entering the village. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Rihan village, stormed several homes, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv"

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads;</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint;</u> At 10:00 and again at 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya, temporarily detained Majdi Abdallah (A resident of Bruqin village) then released him later. • <u>Wall Gates;</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction;</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure;</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads;</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Settler Violence;</u> At 04:35, Israeli settlers positioned near Beit Ibba junction assaulted Abdel Qadder Al-Masri and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to

(ii) At 11:40 and again at 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jiftlik village, detained 2 residents until 23:45 • Raid: At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:40. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained two residents: Abdel-Jabber Bashirat and Hani Atwani in Al-Jiftlik village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Rumani (16 years old) in Al-Oja village. • Attack: At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Newi'meh village junction at the north entrance of Jericho fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Jallatiya leaving him hospitalised with contusions • Home Demolitions: At 12:20, Israeli forces stormed Al- Newi'meh village junction at the north entrance of Jericho and served demolition orders for 13 homes and a barracks owned by Al-Rushaydeh Family for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli military and administrative control.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walajja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 24:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed and searched several homes, detained a residents then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Shushah in Husan village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child: Ramzi Abu Ajamiya (14 years old) and Mohammad Abu Qamil after being struck with tear gas grenade canisters. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Um Al-Rakabeh area in Al-Khadr, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Yazen Al-Salam (13 years old) then released him later. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Kisan village with Bulldozers and levelled six dunumes (Acres) of agricultural land owned by Al-Rushatydeh and Al-Abiyat families. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-^cArrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
