ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.
JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the settler bypass road connecting 'Assur Hill in the village of Kafr Malik to Alon settler bypass road.

	<p>(iv) On 07 July 2007, the Israeli army closed with cement blocks the entrance to the village of At Tira.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on 08 July 2007, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 female civilian. (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the villages of Qarawat Bani Zeid and Mazari' an Nubani and patrolled the area until 15:00. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Nada Jamal al Jayyousi, a female civilian, in the city of Ramallah.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al Kufeir and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of Al Far'a and Al Badhan and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Az Zababida, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian. • Raids/Attacks/Injury/Confiscation/Destruction of Property: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of Zububa and patrolled the area until 16:20. (ii) At 22:50, the Israeli army, including 20 jeeps, raided the village of Ash Shuhada' and opened fire towards a civilian vehicle transporting 5 civilians, which fled. The Israeli army also opened fire towards another civilian vehicle, killing 1 armed Palestinian individual and injuring 1 civilian. In addition, the Israeli army searched a number of houses, arrested 6 civilians, and confiscated 2 M16 rifles as well as 3 pistols. The Israeli army also destroyed 1 civilian vehicle (using explosives) and withdrew at 03:00.

	<p>(iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 20 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided and patrolled the city of Jenin and Jenin refugee camp. In the city, the Israeli army occupied several houses and converted them into military posts. At 07:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> <p>(iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tubas, searched 1 house, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 05:00.</p> <p>(v) At 03:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tammun.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Killing:</u> The Israeli army killed Mahmoud Najeeb Nazzal in the village of Ash Shuhada’. • <u>Arrests:</u> <p>(i) Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Az Zababida arrested Ma’een Ahmed Abu Salah.</p> <p>The Israeli army arrested 6 civilians in the village of Ash Shuhada:</p> <p>(ii) Hilal Sa’eed as Suweiti;</p> <p>(iii) Amjad Hasan Washahi;</p> <p>(iv) Ahmed Mohammed Hanaysheh;</p> <p>(v) ‘Uthman Hussein Washahi;</p> <p>(vi) Ma’moun Mohammed Hanaysheh; and</p> <p>(vii) Naji Mahmoud Hanaysheh.</p> <p>(viii) The Israeli army arrested Muneer Feissal Sawaftah in the town of Tubas.</p>
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil plain; the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa; the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamish.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to Dahiyat Dhinnaba in the city of Tulkarem.</p> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at ‘Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city) and denied access to civilians between 16 and 35 years of age. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the villages of Ramin and Bizzariya and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:20. • <u>Raids:</u> <p>(i) At 00:05, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided and patrolled Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem.</p>

	<p>(iii) At 02:10, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled Tulkarem refugee camp.</p>
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun as well as the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Izbat at Tabib. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access. (ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya and the village of Talluza and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids/House Occupation/Detentions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:10, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of Bizzariya and patrolled the area.

	<p>(ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 18 jeeps, raided the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp, occupied 1 building, and converted it into a military post. Having detained residents, the Israeli army also searched 2 other buildings and arrested 4 civilians as well as 1 Palestinian General Intelligence officer. At 03:35, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Islam Ahmed Salahat, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer; (ii) Omar ‘Adli as Sayeh; (iii) Usamah ‘Adli as Sayeh; (iv) Nidhal Fayeash Shakhshsheer; and (v) Mohammed Tayseer Hashash.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint, impede civilian access, and deny access to civilians between 16 and 35 years of age. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el. • Raid: At 23:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Farkha.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al ‘Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al ‘Auja along Al Mu’arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu’mān, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Dar Salah, set up a checkpoint, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 13 jeeps, raided the city of Bethlehem, searched 1 building, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 05:00. (iii) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Omar Khalil Ziyadeh in the city of Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, and again at 23:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. (ii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Ar Rihya. (iii) At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya, searched a number of houses, and destroyed a house door (using explosives). In addition, the Israeli army served summons to 2 civilians as well as 1 Palestinian Preventive Security officer to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. At 02:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iv) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhul. • <u>Detentions:</u> Israeli troops positioned at Ar Ramadin checkpoint detained 2 brothers, including a Palestinian Police officer, and released them at a later time, after having fined them for a sum of NIS 2,000, claiming that they were on an Israeli territory.

Only humanitarian cases are allowed access, after prior coordination. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> In the morning on 08 July 2007, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. (ii) Ash Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open for transportation of fuel. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At noon on 08 July 2007, 2 mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not reported.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not reported.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing was partially open to a number of trucks transporting food supplies. (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing was partially open to a number of trucks transporting food supplies.
