JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on July 10th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, searched the home of Shireen Al-Iwasi (An Attorney) and confiscated a computer and a telephone. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> On the evening of July 8th 2012, Israeli forces

	<p>confiscated 3 residential barracks used by 3 families and owned by Mohammad Ka'anba in Beit Hanina.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabrud Bridge. • <u>Settler Assault:</u> At 19:00, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles as they were passing along the main road near Al-Jalazun camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Qad village. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:20, the Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces Al-Sahil area in Al-Fatr'a and obliged several construction workers to halt construction on a well for allegedly not having a construction permit.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:30, the Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 06:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Attil junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. (ii) At 06:35, Israeli forces raided Anabta. (iii) At 06:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghsun and set up a checkpoint. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in

	<p>the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.</p>
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Azzun and near Jit village. (ii) At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. (iii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Hajja village and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Immatin village, levelled a plot of agricultural land owned by Jamal Nassar and uprooted several olive trees. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Laqif and stormed a home. (iii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Al-Shilo near Hajja village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction. (ii) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Asira Al-Shamaliya. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Burin village. (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Nablus. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned at Yitsahar settlement junction opened fire towards the outskirts of Burin village for alleged firing fire works towards the settlement.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city

	<p>to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) Israeli forces increased its restrictions to access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho while protecting a group of Israeli settlers as they raided a Synagogue then withdrew at 21:10.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces raided Jinata. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:00, a demonstration took place in the church of Nativity in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues

- to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samou' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 09:35 and again at 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Hebron.
 - (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Karza junction.
 - (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction.
 - (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints along the main road of Beit Awwa, Khursa village junction and at the entrance of Marah Al-Bakar village.
 - (v) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.
 - (vi) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at Sa'ir junction, Zif village junction and at the entrance of Qalqas village.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Suba village.
 - (ii) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'.
 - (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Dura.
 - (iv) At 11:50 and again at 21:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several merchant shops and homes.
 - (v) At 02:30, Israeli forces Kharsa, Nuba and Ithna.
 - (vi) At dawn on July 10th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, fired stun and teargas grenades and detained 3 residents including a child.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Alaa Sabarna (15 years), Ibrahim Sabarna and Muhab Bahar in Beit Ummar.
 - **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) At 18:30, an Israeli settler's vehicle ran over Mohammad Mahraq (14 years) near Al-Samou' junction leaving him hospitalised with broken limbs and sever contusions.
 - (ii) On the evening of July 9th 2012, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near Al-Nabi Musa junction along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem damaging Ashraf Harthies vehicle.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles towards Khan Yunis and Rafah. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah leaving 1 resident injured. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards the Green Line.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At dawn on July 10th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Gaza.
