#### WEST BANK

#### Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Oalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Khan Al-Amar junction located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho.
- **Raid:** At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya and detained five residents.

(i) At 03:00 on July 8th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents:

- (i) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 22:35, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate near Abu Dis junction fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur neighbourhood fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 18:30, Israeli settlers assaulted Mohammad Al-Bahit (17 years old) in Jerusalem and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 20:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured Haytham Abu Hassan near "Tel Al-Biyut" settlement junction and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

- (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village, stormed a gas station withdrew at 23:05.
- (iii) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and detained a resident.
- (iv)At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and detained two residents.

#### **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Rabah Fanoun in Nihalin.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Jafar Sabah and Iz-AlDin Sabah in Tagou'.

#### **Wall Construction:**

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

#### **Raids:** At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron.

- Attack: At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron, at the entrance of Beit Ummar, near Khursa, Zif and Al-Tabaqa village junctions, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 journalists: Sari Al-Awawi and Eyad Al-Halmoushia after being struck by tear gas grenade canisters
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

### At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank **ALL** Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah. **DISTRICTS** Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 320 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 47 residents including 7 children, 11 Women and a Journalist and also inured 376 residents including 65 children and 41 woman ,destroyed 36 homes and damaged 164 other homes as well as damaging A European funded Hospital "European Hospital", the emergency Room for the Palestinian Red Crescent and damaged 3 ambulances. Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by infiltrated into "Zakim" Military base in Israel and launched 100 projectiles.

# • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients and Emergencies.
