<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma village. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata and impeded the free flow of traffic after confrontations erupted between Israeli forces and residents. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on July 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Anata. (ii) At dawn on July 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village and detained two residents. (iii) At 05:05 on July 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained three residents. (iv) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents attempting to climb the wall in order to pray at Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces detained Munthir Al-Jaghoub (A resident of Nablus) in Jerusalem. (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Ikksa checkpoint detained two residents: Abdel-Fatah Taha and Abdel-Rauf Shamasneh (Both residents of Qutna village). (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Sneineh and Mohammad Odwan in Kafr Aqab village. (iv) Israeli forces detained Amjad Al-Sous, Wissam Al-Hout and Ahmad Al-Roz in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Home Demolition:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 8th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Ain Al-Loz area in Silwan neighbourhood and served a military order for the demolition of a home and a barracks used as a vehicle repair shop for allegedly being built without licences. (ii) On July 8th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Abu Al-Nuwar area located in Abu Dis and served military orders to halt construction on homes for several Bedouin families who were forcibly removed from their area of residence in Bawabet Al-Quds area in east Abu Dis and told residents to issue any complaints with the Israeli courts in “Bet El” settlement on July 22nd 2015. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho and detained a National Security Force officer. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and impeded the free flow of traffic until 24:00. • Detention: Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho detained Khaled Abu Odeh (A resident of Ramallah).
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Detention: At 17:40 on July 8th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint in Arabba detained Ayham Abu Al-Rub (A resident of Jallboun) as mentioned in the previous report. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Assault: At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned near Azzun Atma village assaulted Ahmad Missi (A resident of Nablus) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 10:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:55. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction (located along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya) until 20:20. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 23:00. (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement junction in North Huwara. • Settlement Activity: On July 8th 2015, Israeli authorities issued licences for the construction of 12 homes in "Shivut Arahil" settlement and "Shilo" settlement to be implemented by the Israeli Ministry of Public works and Housing on Palestinian owned land occupied in 1967.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p>JERICO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 14:00. (iii) At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 14:00. (iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Faradis village. (v) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North West entrance of Beit Jallah until 01:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 06:45, Israeli forces positioned at checkpoint (300) located in North Bethlehem temporarily detained the child Nour Manasra (16 years old){A resident of Bani Na'im in Hebron} as she was travelling for prayer at Al-Aqsa mosque compound then assaulted her and released her at a later time.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Detention: At 21:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Alaa Abu Ayash (15 year sold) and Omar Aby Ayash (15 years old) near the entrance of Beit Ummar. • Land Levelling: At 11:00, Israeli forces levelled a plot of land near the wall gate in Kharas town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'ya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
