JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Beitin until 22:30. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:40, a demonstration took place near Ofar prison in

	<p>Beituniya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards the demonstrators for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba junction until 08:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces raided the area between Ya’bad and Kafriyat village until 08:35. (ii) At 13:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamun. • Detention: At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jammala checkpoint detained Sabiha Al-Arda, a resident of Arraba upon her return from visiting an Israeli prison and released her at 18:35. • Settler Violence: At 10:45, Israeli settlers raided the previously abandoned settlement of Homesh and withdrew at a later time. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 10:20, the Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: At 11:10, the Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:10. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusun and Al-Jaurshat village. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Anabta. (iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya. (iv) At 20:15 and again at 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. • Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

<p>QALQILYA</p>	<p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Azzun, searched several homes, detained Adnan Shbieta (a National Security officer), interrogated his wife, confiscated a fire arm (gun) and detained 8 residents including 3 children. (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Qussay Mashal (16 years), Hani Abu Haniya (17 years), Alaa Radwan (16 years), Hamdallah Abu Haniya, Fadi Saleem, Muntasir Radwan, Luia Huwari and Asa'ad Hussien in Azzun. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ghassan Odeh in Kafr Thulth. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 14:00, Israeli force positioned near Qaddumim settlement assaulted Mohammad Al-Tayem (a mentally challenged individual) (52 years) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, Israeli settlers assaulted Shafiq Bayda (72 years) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 10:15. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron junction and detained a security officer. (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in north Huwwara until 21:30. (iv) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction until 21:15. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Huwwara until 21:30. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 01:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:35 on July 10th 2012, Israeli forces detained Rabi' Khalifa during their raid into Nablus.

	(ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Mahmoud near Shave Shomron settlement.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) Israeli forces increased its restrictions to access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction. • Raid: At 01:05 Israeli forces raided Jericho until 02:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 11:50. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00 and again at 01:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed several merchant, shops, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:45. (ii) At 11:05 and again at 03:25, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iii) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar. (iv) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Husan village, detained a resident then withdrew at

(ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Da’asna in Bethlehem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Jamal Hamarna in Husan village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Annun. (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction. (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron, closed the gate entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Wadi Al-Jouz road which connects Hebron city and Bani Na’im. (v) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwwar camp. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:35, Israeli forces raided Yatta and searched a home. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Dura and summoned Nu’mān Dreba’ to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Sa’ir, stormed several homes and detained a resident. (iv) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuyukh, stormed a home, temporarily detained Oday Haliqa then withdrew at a later time. (v) At dawn on July 11th 2012, Israeli forces Hebron, stormed several homes and detained a university student. (vi) At dawn on July 11th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed a home, fired stun grenades towards a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces detained Faraj Jamal and Rasahad Jabir after storming their homes in the old city of Hebron’s H2 area which is under Israeli administrative and military control. (ii) Israeli forces detained Fihmy Al-Shalada in Sa’ir.

	<p>(iii) Israeli forces detained Sayef Taha in Hebron.</p> <p>(iv) Israeli forces detained Jalal Al-Ra'i in Beit Ummar.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron assaulted Ma'zouz Al-Tumayzi and Wael Al-Tumayzi leaving them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Ya'coub Abu Sha'ban (National Security officer) in the old city of Hebron H2 area and released him at 18:30. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 09:40, Israeli forces demolished water well in northern Hebron owned Al-Sa'id family for allegedly not having proper licencing. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:35, Israeli settlers stoned several International peace activists; during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards the peace activists as they attempted to prevent the settler attack which left a peace activist injured with contusions after being hit by a tear gas grenade canister and Israeli forces closed down several shops. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
