JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem and prevented residents from entering or leaving the area. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on July 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents: Khadr Al-Amouri, Abdel Salam Issa, Sayf Salam and Sufiyan Salam in Shu’afat

Israeli forces detained five residents: Mohammad Abu Teir, Ehab Abu Teir, Karim Abu Teir, Mohammad Iz Abu Teir and Obeida Amireh in Sur Bahar village. (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces detained Amir Al-Qawasmeh in Beit Hanina (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces detained Amar Sarhan in Silwan. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned Qalandiya checkpoint junction fired live ammunition, towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Qusbah (16 years old). (iii) At 00:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of July 10th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented worshipers from conducting Dawn prayers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:30, an Israeli settler positioned in Aqbat Al-Siriya area located in the old city of Jerusalem hurled a firebomb towards Al-Salfiti family home. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbzie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 20:45. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Sira. (ii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Ni'ilin and stormed and searched two homes.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Pisagot” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Issam Asfour and detained two residents including a child. (iii) At 05:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned near “Pesigout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city detained Nur Abed (16 years old) and Mohammad Hamawdeh. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:50, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement junction stoned residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:10, Israeli forces detained Ali Qassis during their raid into Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 13:50, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided the area between Tel and Assira Al-Qibliya villages, fired flash grenades into the sky, surveyed the area then withdrew at 03:00 (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Burin village, fired flash grenades into the sky, surveyed the area then withdrew at 04:35. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:55, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mas'udiya area in Burqa village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli settlers stormed Iraq Burin village and set fire to agricultural land and as a result destroyed several Olive trees before Palestinian Civil defence forces extinguished the fire.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 03:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:00. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a check point at the north entrance of Salfit and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the main steel entrance gate then reopened it at 17:50 (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dier Balout until 04:05. • Detention: At 03:05, Israeli forces positioned near "Ariel" settlement detained two residents; Mohammad Ans and Khaldoun Al-Sarouji for allegedly finding explosives in their vehicle and confiscated the vehicle. • Settler Violence: At 02:10, Israeli settler positioned near Marda village stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:40 and again at 03:15,,Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District after closing the checkpoint then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near road (90) junction located in Al-Newi'meh village at the north entrance of Jericho until 16:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, temporarily detained Abdallah Najda and released him later then withdrew at 21:25. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, stormed a home then withdrew at 02:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Harmalah village, clashed with residents as they stormed a home then withdrew at 23:00. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, detained three residents including a child then withdrew at 04:20. (iii)At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou'.

	<p>(iv) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and detained a resident.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Shiusheh (A resident of Husan village). (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Bakr Shusheh (16 years old), Mohammad Zaghoul and Tal'at Hamarat in Husan village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Muslit in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:55, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents: Ahamd Odeh, Ziyad Abu Sawi, Yazid Faraj, Mohammad Sha'fout and Salah Jawarish. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Husan village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2013, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:20, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bani Na'im with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil. • <u>Raids:</u> At 19:30 and again at 21:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron, clashed with several residents near Bab Al-Zawiya area then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:05, Israeli forces positioned at Zif village junction, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz area located near the entrance of Bani Na'im fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. • On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah. • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 341 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 22 residents including 6 children and a Women and also injured 194 residents including 82 children and 21 women ,destroyed 156 homes(35 of which were completely destroyed and 121 of which were partially destroyed which brings up the number of homes destroyed since the Israeli attacks on Gaza to 486 homes including 88 of which were completely destroyed and 380 of which were partially destroyed. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 300 projectiles. {The total number of Projectiles launched from Gaza towards the Green line total to 800 since the Israeli attacks on Gaza }

- (i) Israeli airstrikes killed Nour Al-Jindi (11 years old) in south Rafah.
