	Closure: (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a
	hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to
	construct the wall.

(i) At 22:30 Israeli forces positioned Qalandiya and Shu'fat checkpoints, near the wall gate in Abu Dis, at the entrances of Anata and Al-Eisawiya,

at Al-Ram junction, in Al-Suwana neighbourhood, in Bab Hata and Hara Al-Sa'diya neighbourhoods in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Rawhi Abu Dahoud (A resident of Hebron) leaving him hospitalised with contusions as well as leaving several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

• <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces clashed with residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and detained 2 resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At dawn on July 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sumarin after storming his home in Al-Thawri neighbourhood in Jerusalem and confiscated a computer.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Ghafour Al-Za'ir and Eyad Al-Taweel in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks.
- (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibzie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on July 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya, detained four residents including a child and again at 04:00 detained three other residents (7 total residents detained) then withdrew at 04:10.
- (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Kharbathat Al-Misbah village.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained seven residents: Mohammad Issa (14 years old), Mohammad Radi, Mohammad Hamaydeh, Rafat Samhan, Khalil Radi, Bajis Samhan and Mus'ab Samhan in Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya.

• Attack:

- (i) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Ofar" military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Awad Al-Nabali and Hamad Abu Samarah.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Raid:

- (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a building (under construction) clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:25.
- (ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Al-Deir village located near Tagou' until 22:40.
- (iii)At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ta'mar village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 00:35.
- (iv)At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Ma'assrah and detained two residents.
- (v) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and detained two residents.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Barayjeh and Mahmoud Zawahreh in Al-Ma'assrah village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Sabah and Muhanad Al-Ta'amreh in Tagou'.
- Attack: At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child: Bashar Rabay'a and Mohammad Al-Maghribi.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-

- Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

HEBRON

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:20. Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bani Na'im with dirt mounds.

• Raid:

- (i) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several homes (Apartments), detonated open the main entrance of Munjid Al-Humouri's home and detained seven residents.
- (ii) At 04:00. Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a PLC member.
- (iii)At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Samiya village clashed with several residents and as a result killed a resident and injured another after opening fire towards them using live ammunition and then prevented medical unites from reaching them to transport them to a hospital.
- (iv)At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a PLC member.
- (v) At 04:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and detained a resident.
- Killing: Israeli forces killed Munir Al-Badarin in Al-Samiya village.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained seven residents: Arafat Al-Qawasmi, Wahib Al-Natsheh, Tamer Al-Taweel, Adnan Al-Zour, Anwar Al-Joulani, Ja'far Al-Qawasmi and Tarik Al-Taweel in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Jahisheh (a PLC member) in Ithna.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Nayef Al-Roujob (a PLC member) in Dura.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Tal in Al-Thahriya.

Attack:

- (i) At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned near Halhul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area, the entrances of Surif, Beit Ummar, Bani Na'im, Al-Urub camp and at Zif and Khursa village junctions, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents: Ahmad Hadib, Mahmoud Baraghith and Mohammad Jum'a.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

• At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire.

• On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.

• Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.

Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 376 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah{which brings up the number of Air strikes since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 1980} and as a result killed 9 residents including 2 Women and 2 elderly residents and also inured 109 residents including 31 children and 22 women ,{ which increases the of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 1147 -373 children and 193 Women}destroyed 268 homes(40 of which were completely destroyed and 228 of which were partially destroyed which brings up the number of homes destroyed since the Israeli attacks on Gaza to 1512 homes including 216 of which were completely destroyed and 1296 of which were partially destroyed and Israeli airstrikes destroyed 2 mosques in Gaza which increases the amount of mosques destroyed by Israeli airstrikes to 21 including 3 destroyed completely and 18 partially destroyed since the Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.

• Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 137 projectiles.

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients and Emergencies.

• Attack:

- (i) On July 13th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired tank Artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun, East Jabaliya and North Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) On July 13th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels launched missiles towards Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
