JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram.</li> <li>(iii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents and detained three children.</li> <li>(iv) At 05:25, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained a National Security Force officer after storming his home.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 03:20, Israeli forces detained the child Mohammad Shihadeh (17 years old) in Jerusalem for allegedly entering the city without a permit.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Zabidi (A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp).</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained three children: Mohammad Muhsien (13 years old), Ali Mahmoud (13 years old) and Akfram Mustafa (15 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village.</li> <li>(iv) Israeli forces detained Ashraf Ammar in Qalandiya camp.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed a home and as a result injured 2 residents: Nafith Al-Dameeri (eye injury) and Mohammad Al-Dabi’ (wound to the abdomen).</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 17:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Mahkama checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city and closed the checkpoint by burning several tires in front the checkpoint entrance.</li> </ul>

<p><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> At 21:55, Israeli forces positioned at “Salem” military base detained Ragheb Al-Najjar as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>

<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 12:30.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. <p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Deir Ballout and Rafaat village.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 16:15, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village until 16:50.</li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> On July 11<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli settlers uprooted 80 Olive trees as the levelled a plot of agricultural land in Deir Istya for expanding a settlement road located in the west area of Deir Istya.</li> </ul>
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 16:50.</li> </ul>

<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Susiya village and forced residents out of their homes.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh, clashed with several residents after storming and searching a home, detained a resident bthen withdrew at 03:15.</li> <li>(iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 02:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Islam Al-Atrash and Mohammad Al-Karaki in the old city of Hebron.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained Majd Al-Halayqa in Al-Shiyoukh.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Amro in Dura.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>ALL DISTRICTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza</li> <li>• Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.</li> </ul>
