JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. (iii) On 28 May 2010, the Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and told civilians to pass through Qalandiya checkpoint to Jerusalem city. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Isawiya and demolished 3 houses under the pretext of not having construction licenses. Confrontations took place with civilians while attempting to confront army bulldozers. As a result, the civilian woman Sabah Abu Rmaileh was injured. (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Hanina and demolished a house under the pretext of not having a construction license. (iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Mikhmas, arrested 2 civilians and served summons to a number of civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the village of Mikhmas the civilians Baha' Muhammad Mousa Abu Ali and Saddam Najeh Thalji Abu Ali. • House Demolition: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army demolished 2 houses in the area of As Sal'a, located between the neighborhoods of Silwan and Jabal Al Mukhabber in occupied Jerusalem city, under the pretext of not having construction licenses. The houses belong to the civilians Ahmad Mousa Mashahreh and 'Amer At-Taweel.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army demolished 3 houses in the village of Al Isawiya belonging to the civilian woman Sabah Abu Rmeileh and civilians Mahmoud Muhammad Naser and Hisham Khalil Abdallah Ad-Dari. (iii) The Israeli army demolished a house in the area of Al 'Aqaba in Beit Hanina town belonging to the civilian Rashed Ar-Rajabi. • <u>Demonstration:</u> In the evening of 13 July 2010, a mass demonstration, with the participation of international peace activists, took place in Ash Shaikh Jarrah neighborhood in occupied Jerusalem city against establishing settlement projects, seizing houses, the policy of expulsion from occupied Jerusalem city and in solidarity with 3 PLC members and a former minister who are threatened by the Israeli authorities to revoke their Jerusalem IDs and expel them from their homes in the occupied city. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. (ii) On 15 March 2010, the Israeli army issued military order declaring the area located between civilian houses and the Wall in the town of Ni'lin and the village of Bil'in as closed military zones from 08:00 until 20:00 every Friday and for a period of 6 months. Civilian access is denied during the mentioned period without a special permit in order to prevent the weekly demonstrations against the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues west of the towns and villages of 'Abud and Bil'in, and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to 'Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Meithalun and the village of Sanur and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:00. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Meithalun.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Az-Zababida, searched a building used as dormitories for students from the Arab – American University, detained a number of students and conducted field interrogation with them and released them at a later time and withdrew at 04:30. (iii) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Qabatiya, searched a number of houses and arrested 3 civilians. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the town of Qabatiya the civilians Ayman Abdulrahman Abu Ar-Rub; Ahmad Nafe' Abu Ar-Rub; and Muhammad Ahmad Kamil. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint, east of the city of Tubas, allowing civilian access from 06:00 to 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road. • Demonstration: At 11:30, a sit in demonstration by families of political prisoners took place in front of the ICRC in the city of Tulkarm in solidarity with their children in Israeli jails and demanding their release. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Azzun. Again at 16:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 21:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and arrested a civilian. (iii) At 23:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of Jinsafut and Al Funduq. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Al Funduq. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Habla. (iii) At 16:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya until 17:40.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Azzun. (v) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Jit, searched a house and served summon to the civilian Nihad Muhyiddin Muhammad Siddah to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested at the entrance to the city of Qalqiliya the civilian Noor Farah Robin Samhan. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. (ii) On 12 May 2010, the Israeli army erected an iron gate at the entrance to the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha (after removing the iron gate erected at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya), and prevented civilians from the village from passing through it. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through the iron gate # 109.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Naqura village opposite Shavei Shomron settlement. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00. (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Beita and patrolled the area.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances of 2 side roads between the village of Marda and its agricultural land. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan, searched a house, served summon to a civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency and withdrew at 16:50. (ii) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir Istiya, searched a house, served summon to the civilian Ahmad Abdulrahman Ahmad Khalaf to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency and withdrew at 02:30. (iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda and served summon to the civilian Jad Na'im Al Khuffash to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those with permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to Road # 90 in the middle of Al Auja village. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:05 on 13 July 2010, the Israeli army raided the village of Fasayil and served summons to 4 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. They are: Ayesh Muhammad Nawawrah; Mu'ayyad Eshtayyan Shalalfah; Ahmad Saleh Nawawrah; and Saleem Muhammad Nawawrah. (ii) At 12:20, the Israeli army raided agricultural land located west of Jericho city in area (A), that falls under Palestinian sovereignty, and patrolled the area until 12:50.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu'a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq'a. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, the Israeli army closed As Sawahira Ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint in both directions and re-opened it later.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Um Rukba near Al Khadr town and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Arrest:</u> At 23:30, the Israeli army arrested at As Sawahira Ash Sharqiya (the ‘Container’) checkpoint the civilian Khadr Dheeb Salah Al Hroub from the village of Deir Samit in Hebron district after finding 10 kg of gold in his possession. • <u>Military Post:</u> At 20:00, the Israeli army erected a tent on An Nahla Mountain near the village of Artas and a number of Israeli soldiers gathered inside it. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada’ Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Having evacuated civilian residents and denied civilian access, the Israeli army continues to close the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa’; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab’a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-‘Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of At-Tabaqa. Again at 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles.

(iii) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to the town of Halhul. Again at 19:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 14:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Wadi Qabun (at the northern entrance to Hebron city off bypass road # 35) and searched civilians and vehicles. (v) At 19:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Kahil. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Halhul town. (ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army raided Hebron city, set up a flying checkpoint and patrolled the area. Again at 00:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area. (iii) At 01:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta and arrested a civilian. (iv) At 02:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Surif town. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested in the town of Yatta the civilian Ahmad Yousef 'Ewais. • <u>Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, the Israeli army detained in the old city of Hebron police officer Nidal Al 'Uwaiwi while storming and searching his house and released him at a later time. (ii) At 20:20, the Israeli army detained in the neighborhood of Al Ja'bari in the old city of Hebron the General Intelligence officer Mithqal Al Ja'bari and released him at a later time following DCO intervention. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On 11 July 2010, the Israeli army issued military order # 502 to evacuate and confiscate about 30 dunums of civilian agricultural land in the areas of Abu Haltam and Um Al Khanazir and Al Jalamun Valley that belong to the town of Beit Ula for military purposes and under the pretext of being state property. The Israeli army gave civilians 45-day notice to appeal the confiscation order. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil. |

GAZA STRIP

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period. • The Israeli army violated the ceasefire by raiding Palestinian territory, opening fire in Central Gaza and Khan Yunis districts and opening fire from its locations on the Green Line in the district of Northern Gaza. As a result, a civilian woman was killed and 6 other civilians were injured, including a child.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals. • Attack: In the morning of 14 July 2010, the Israeli army opened fire from its locations on the Green Line towards a number of civilians in the periphery of Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing north of Beit Hanun town. As a result, 13-year-old child Ehmaid Ahmad 'Obaid was injured.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. (ii) Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: In the evening of 13 July 2010, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and bulldozers covered by reconnaissance aircrafts, raided east of Al Bureij refugee camp, opened fire intensively and fired a number of tank shells towards civilian agricultural land and houses killing a civilian woman and injuring 5 other civilians and damaging a house. • Killing: The Israeli army killed east of Al Bureij refugee camp the civilian woman Ni'mah Yousef Abu Es'aid.
<p style="text-align: center;">KHAN YOUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: In the morning of 13 July 2010, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and 2 bulldozers covered by reconnaissance aircrafts, raided Palestinian territory east of Al Qarara town and opened fire intensively towards civilian agricultural land and houses while leveling an area of agricultural land.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is open. It allows the departure of civilian patients, students and visa holders, and the entry of civilians and patients who received treatment at Egyptian hospitals. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transport of food, humanitarian assistance, a quantity of industrial diesel for the electricity plant and cooking gas.
