JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) On July 13th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim. 		

	 <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
	Raid: (i) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Rantis village, fired flash grenades then withdrew at 22:20. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al Barib eitr parti 04:00.
	(ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Berih city until 04:00. (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Silwad until 03:30.
	• <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 00:30, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles along the main road between Jalazun camp and Bet El.
RAMALLAH &	Demonstrations: (i) At 13:30, Palestinian and International peace activists demonstrated in Bil'in against land confiscation and against the legality of the wall; Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades leaving several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
AL BIREH	(ii) At 13:30, Palestinian and International activists demonstrated in Ni'lin against the construction of the wall; Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades injuring Haytham AL-Khatib, a journalist and leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
	 (iii) At 13:40, Palestinian and international activists demonstrated in Al-Nabi Saleh village against the construction of the separation wall; Israeli forces fired teargas towards the demonstrators, leaving causing several cases of suffocation from teargas inhalation and damaged furniture after firing tear gas grenades towards a home as well as detaining 4 international peace activists. (iv) At 14:50, a demonstration took place near Ofar prison, in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and clashed with Israeli forces.
	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al- Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
JENIN	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. Checkpoints: At 16:30, Israeli army continues their restrictions on Palestinian
TULKAREM	 access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Raid: At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed a bakery then withdrew at 17:05.
IULKAKENI	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
	Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

	and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint
	and impede the free flow of traffic.

	• Flying Checkpoint: At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Harris and Kafil Harris village until 16:30.
	• Raid: At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Burqin, Kafir Al-Dik and Deir Ballout until 00:30.
	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
	Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks.
JERICHO	Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.
	(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.
	• Raid: At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village until 23:50.
	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the
	exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
	(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

	 <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Osama Al-Tamimi. <u>Assault on Property:</u> On July 13th 2012, Israeli forces served demolition notices
	to demolish 4 water wells owned by Mohammad Sbieh in Al-Kahdr.
	• <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:25, a demonstration took place in Maasra against the Israeli settlements and the separation wall; Israeli forces fired tear gas towards the participants, leaving several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
	• Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition
	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2000, the Israeli army has along the great lengths.
