WEST BANK

Closure: On July 13th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the (i) entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound with the exception of Men over the age of 50 and children below the age of 12 and Women over the age of 30 as well as girls under the age of 16 years old as well as those residents holding permits for Taraweeh prayers. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the (ii) area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing **JERUSALEM** point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. **Temporary Detention:** At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Sahara gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) temporarily detained Khader Adnan (A resident of Qabatiya in Jenin) then released him after questioning at a detention centre. Attack: (i) At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Qabsa area located in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned near the North Al-Ram Junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. **RAMALLAH &** (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet **AL BIREH**

El" settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. **Flying Checkpoint:** At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of

Um Safa village until 02:00.

	50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
	(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with
	dirt mounds.
	(viii) On January 28 th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of
	Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002}
	and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily
	bases.

July 14th 2015

Physical Assault: At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Hums area located in Notyh Bethlehem assaulted Anas Al-Shiekh and as a result, left him hospitalised
with contusions.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Raid:** At dawn on July 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 02:00 on July 13th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Rajabi in the old city of Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces detained Tarik Al-Awawi (A resident of Al-Jalajlah area located in east Hebron).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Al-Natah in Ithna.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza

NORTHERN GAZA

• Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination as well as issued permits for 800 residents over the age of 50 to pray in Al-Aqsa mosque compound.

GAZA

• Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
- (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: On July 14th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Maghazi camp. Detention: At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in east Al-Buriej camp detained two unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
