JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - **Raid:** At 11:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 12:10.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during which they raided Abu Dis and stormed and searched the Palestinian Civil defence headquarters in Abu Dis as they searching for the alleged stoners, detained a University students then withdrew at 01:30.
 - (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Anata and Al-Eisawiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Assault on Places of Worship:** On the morning of July 14th 2014, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) On July 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained 15 residents including 10 children: Nidal Zaghloul (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Sneneh (14 years old), Suliman Al-Ajlouni (14 years old), Munir Al-Ajlouni (14 years old), Mohammad Al-Rashaq (16 years old), Samer Abu Sharkh (16 years old), Hassan Ghayth (16 years old), Abdel Rahman Bassit (15 years old), Mustafa Al-Safadi (14 years old), Habib Mukhdir (14 years old), Hassan Abu Qdrus, Mohammad Al-Dweik, Amjad Abu Sneneh and Fathi Jamal in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - (ii) On July 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mahdi Attoun, Hussien Amireh and Mohammad Abu Teir in Sur Bahar village.
 - (iii) On July 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained Rateb Al-Khadour (15 years old) near Biddu.
 - (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained two residents Majdi Al-Rajabi and Mohammad Al-Rajabi in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Alaa Al-Sharif (A University student) {Resident of Hebron} in Abu Dis.
 - **Temporary Detention:** At 15:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained two children Hamza Al-Rimlawi (12 years old) and Amir Shawarneh (12 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 20:40. (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Yahya Al-Dawadra, Muntasir Al-Dawadra and Fawaz Al-Dawadra in Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Hamad, Mohammad Hamad and Abdallah Al-Salhi in Silwad. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Deir Qaddus village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hassan Awad (14 years old). (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Turmusaya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and

	<p>impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages until 22:35. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces detained Rami Bayari (A resident of Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem) as he attempted to cross into Israel for work. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate (664) in Shwakiya town in Tulkarem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mazen Awad leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 12:30. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 15:45 and again at 04:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 05:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’ tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik and stormed and searched three homes. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned along the bypass road leading to Kafr Al-Dik fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then closed the West entrance then reopened it at 00:30. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On July 14th 2014, Israeli forces served a military order to demolish a home owned by Mohammad Ahmad in Kafr Al-Dik for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, an Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Qarwat Bani Hassan and chopped off the limbs of four Olive trees owned by Rafiq Bisher. (ii) At 02:00, three Israeli settlers stormed the area between Kafil Harris and Harris then withdrew later. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Newi’ meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 08:40. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 18:35.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah until 23:30.
 - (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 01:00.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, detained three residents then withdrew at 04:00.
 - (ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village, temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Shiekh as he was in his store then released him later and withdrew at 03:00.
 - (iii) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, detained a PLC member then withdrew at 04:30.
 - (iv) At 07:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Abdallah Al-Aridi, Mohammad Hamarat and Ahmad Hamarat in Husan village.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Al-Khatib in Al-Ayda camp in

	<p>Bethlehem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents: Ali Arafa, Mohammad Ma'la and Muntasir Barakat as well as suffocating Mahmoud Shahin from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
