JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through

Qalandiya checkpoint.

- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Jericho and Ramallah and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem until 17:10.
- **Raid:** At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, detained 2 residents after storming and searching their homes then withdrew at 04:30.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction, fired live ammunition towards “Al-Dana” Reception Hall as several residents were Breaking their fasting for the Holy month of Ramadan for alleged gun fire from the hall boundaries during which Israeli forces stormed the hall and converted Shadi Hadibs home and converted it into a military post then searched the reception hall and confiscated surveillance camera footage from the reception hall as well as confiscating surveillance camera footage from “Holy Land” reception hall and “Free Line Nutrition” company then withdrew at 04:25.
 - (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents: Ahmad Allawi, Midhat Jarradat, Ibrahim Salah, Mohammad Zien Al-Din and Mohammad Al-Tantouz leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound thus preventing residents from entering the mosque and a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces detained two mosque guards.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) 02:30, Israeli forces detained Billal Ghayth after storming his home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
 - (ii) At 03:50, Israeli forces detained four residents: Subhi Al-Rumani, Musa Abu Khdeir, Mohammad Suwalim and Adnan Abu Khdeir.
 - (iii) Israeli force detained two residents: Mohammad Hamad and Samer Sanduqa in Al-Eizariya.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Tariq Abu Sbieh and Ashraf Abu Irmeleh in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

	<p>IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge until 16:20. • Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Ofar" Military Base/ Prison fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against Israeli Military strikes on the Gaza Strip) for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned near "Bet El" settlement junction located in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in Al-Jalazoun camp for alleged stoning and firing fireworks towards Israeli forces and as a result injured Hamza Al-Shini leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (v) At 00:20, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 01:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Far'a village. • Raid: At 05:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Atiya bIsmail Mahdawi then withdrew later.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Of Azzun. • Raid: At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Jinsafut village until 14:30. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ibba. (ii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Beita. • Attack: At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near “Barcha” checkpoint located in south Nablus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (As they were protesting against Israeli Military strikes towards Gaza)for alleged stoning and as a result set fired to a vehicle owned by Jafar Ishtaya (A journalist) after a tear gas grenade canister exploded inside the vehicle.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Marda village, temporarily detained the child Ishaq Suliman (15 years old) then released him later and withdrew at 20:10. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Rafat village until 02:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Newi'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 20:00. (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in north Jericho. (iv) At 05:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Mu'arajat road, which connects Jericho and Ramallah.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 23:55. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement located along the main road Jericho and Hebron and detained 3 residents including 2 National Security force officers: Obied Thaer, Ehab Thaher and Salam Sulkiman Salam then released them at 23:50 (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 01:30. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taou' until 00:55. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jihad Obiyat (17 years old) in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 02:00 Israeli Forces located around the settlement of (Beitar Eliat) shot fire under the pretext of stone throwing. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

(iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a child: Mu'taz Salhab (17 years old), Na'im Al-Rajabi and Mahmoud Al-Ja'bari. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
