DISTRICT **EVENTS** WEST BANK **Closure:** The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at (i) the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia **JERUSALEM** checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Settler Violence: At 15:20, an Israeli settler positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint opened fire towards Sanad Abu Libda's vehicle leaving her hospitalised with gunshot wounds. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shavyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

JENIN	 <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafr Ra'i and A'llar until 19:10. <u>Raid:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Jabloun village. At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 02:00. <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:00, Israeli settlers raided the previously abandoned settlement of Homesh, assaulted 4 residents and withdrew at a later time. <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:20, the Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. <u>Raid:</u> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Khilat Ijmi' area and put up 3 tents to house several soldiers. (ii) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a camp, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:55. <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Minawi in Al-Far'a camp. <u>Demonstration:</u> At 09:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tubas in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
TULKAREM	 <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Raid:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Allar and Sayda village. <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by firing 3 tank artillery shells towards Khan Yunis.
