Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire.</li> <li>• On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned anglers against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and</li> </ul>

	<p>launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in <b>100</b> consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah{which brings up the number of Air strikes since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to <b>2797</b>} and as a result killed <b>34</b> residents including <b>8</b> children, <b>an</b> Elderly Women and an elderly resident and also inured <b>126</b> residents including <b>1</b> children 1women and a journalist and also forced patients to evacuate Al-Wafa hospital and several; other health clinics as after being bombed by the Israeli air force.</li> <li>• Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching <b>120</b> projectiles.</li> <li>• On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli Military agreed to a temporary cease-fire agreement for a period of 6 hours from 10:00 until 16:00 based on a request by the United Nations in order to allow emergency medical supplies to enter the Gaza Strip.</li> </ul>

<p><b>NORTHERN GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u></b> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients and Emergencies.</li> <li>• <b><u>Incursion:</u></b> At 23:00 on July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli military began the ground invasion of the Gaza strip dubbed “Operation Protective Edge” during which tens of Israeli Military tanks invaded Beit Hanun and east Beit Lahiya under the cover of Israeli air crafts and Naval vessels , opened fire and fired tank artillery shells towards several residents and home towards several areas in North Gaza district and clashed with several Palestinian gunmen and as a result killed 4 residents including a woman and an elderly resident in Beit Hanoun and suffocated 38 residents including 8 children from tear gas inhalation after Israeli forces launched tear gas grenades towards several homes.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired tank Artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun, East Jabaliya and North Beit Lahiya.</li> <li>(ii) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels launched missiles towards Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Air Strike:</u></b> Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several area in North Gaza district which included <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:35, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards Al-Kafarna Family home, which is located in Beit Hanoun and as a result killed a resident.</li> <li>(ii) On the evening of July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets dropped several leaflets on Beit Hanoun and Beit Lahiya ordering them to evacuate their homes.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces killed four residents: Amal Dabour, Ismail Qassim (60 years old), Nassim Massir and Karam Massir during their ground invasion of Beit Hanoun.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli airstrikes killed Ismail Kafarneh in Beit Hanoun.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Palestinian Attack:</u></b> On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014 and at dawn on July 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen launched several projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</li> <li>(ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b></li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched several tank artillery shells towards agricultural land in east Gaza and at 20:40, Israeli forces launched 30 artillery shells towards Al-Shuja'iyah neighbourhood in east Gaza and as a result killed 4 residents including 2 children and injured 24 other including 3 children and 4 Women as well as launching tank artillery shells towards Al-Wafa hospital and as a result injured a resident forcing the hospital to be evacuated.</li> <li>(ii) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels launched artillery shells towards Gaza Port and again at 17:20 towards several children who were playing soccer on the beach near Gaza port and as a result killed four children and critically injured two others.</li> <li>• <b><u>Air Strike:</u></b> Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several area in Gaza district which included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On the morning of July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards Shahabir Family home located on Al-Thulathini road in Gaza city and as a result killed 3 children and injured 3 residents including a child with critically injured.</li> <li>(ii) On the evening of July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets dropped several leaflets on homes in Al-Shuja'iyah neighbourhood ordering them to evacuate their homes.</li> <li>(iii) At 07:00, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards Juhar towers, which consist of several local and foreign media offices and as a result injured Mohammad Shibat (A Journalist).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Yassin Al-Hamidi (4 years old) died of injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes towards Gaza on July 16<sup>th</sup> 2014.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli military tank artillery strikes killed four residents: Mohammad Nutiz (4 years old), Mohammad Nutiz (14 years old), Abed Nutiz and Rani Abu Taweleh in Al-Shuja'ya neighbourhood located in east Gaza.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli airstrikes killed three residents: Jihad Shahabir (8 years old), Wassim Shahabir (7 years old) and Fullah Shahabir (7 years old) Al-Thulathini road in Gaza city.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Palestinian Attack:</u></b> On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014 and at dawn on July 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen launched several projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>

<p><b>KHAN YUNIS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Incursion:</u></b> At 23:00 on July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli military began the ground invasion of the Gaza strip dubbed “Operation Protective Edge” during which tens of Israeli Military tanks invaded east Khan Yunis under the cover of Israeli air crafts and Naval vessels, opened fire and fired tank artillery shells towards several residents and home towards several areas in Khan Yunis district and clashed with several Palestinian gunmen and as a result killed 9 residents and injured 10 others.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards agricultural land near the border fence in east Kahn Yunis.</li> <li>(ii) On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels launched several missiles towards Shata’ area in Khan Yunis.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Air Strike:</u></b> Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several area in Khan Yunis district which included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:35, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards Al-Manara square in Khan Yunis and as a result killed a child.</li> <li>(ii) On the evening of July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets dropped several leaflets on homes in east Khan Yunis ordering them to evacuate their homes.</li> <li>(iii)At 18:20, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several residents in Al-Qarrara city and as a result killed a resident.</li> <li>(iv)At dawn on July 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several residents in West Khan Yunis city and as a result killed a resident and injured another.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli tank artillery shell fire killed 9 residents: Hamad Abu Lahiya, Mohammad Fayad, Mahmoud Fayyad, Billal Radwan, Munthir Radwan, Ahmad Radwan, Mohammad Radwan, Hani Al-Shami, Mohammad Al-Shami east Khan Yunis.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli airstrikes killed Rahaf Jabour (4 years old) Al-Manara square in Khan Yunis.</li> <li>(iii)Israeli airstrikes killed Hamza Al-Obada in Al-Qarara city.</li> <li>(iv)Israeli airstrikes killed Salah Al-Shafi’i in West Khan Yunis.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Palestinian Attack:</u></b> On July 17<sup>th</sup> 2014 and at dawn on July 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen launched several projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
