| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 18th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces set up five checkpoints in Wadi Al-Juz, Al-Masarah, Al-Suwana, Ras Al-Amoud and Salah Al-Din road neighbourhoods in Jerusalem. |

- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu, clashed with several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Wahid Amarnah and detained a resident.
 - (ii) On the evening of July 18th 2014, Israeli forces raided Anata, clashed with several residents and as a result injured two residents including a child: Ibrahim Abdul-Haq (16 years old) and Khalid Al-Silwadi.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 14:30 and again at 23:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Qutna village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 16:00 and again at 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (v) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat, Silwan, Ras Al-Amoud and Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (vi) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village, checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (vii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Anata checkpoint fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (viii) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ix) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma checkpoint fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (x) At 02:00, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Hata area in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Injuries:** At 14:00, 2 residents: Adnana Al-Husseini (Governor of Jerusalem District) and Alaa Hadad were injured during confrontations with Israeli forces in Jerusalem.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 13:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound-fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were conducting Friday prayers) for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Sa; ed Abu Sneneh and Omar Al-Kiswani (Head of Al-Aqsa Mosque).
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Khaled Abu Eid in Biddu.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the areas north and south

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 18:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Aboud fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge in north Bir Zeit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents: Isam Nakhlah, Taha Sama'da and Ramzi Al-Abour. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and Israeli forces detained a resident. (ii) At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Adham Nafi'. (iii) At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Kahtib in Bil'in. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned near "Bet El settlement" located in North Al-Bireh city detained Nidal Hamayel (A resident of Kafr Malik village) then released them later. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages. |
