JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 18th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:55, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Mohammad Sabieh and Arafat Salah Al-Din. (ii) At dawn on July 20th 2014, Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Amar Al-Nabulsi, , Yazen Dweidat, Jawdat Abu Teir and Mohammad Abu Teir after storming their homes in Sur Bahar and Um Tuma villages • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Hizma village junction opened fire towards several residents for alleged stoning of settler vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • Checkpoint: At 14:30 and again at 21:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:05.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109.

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Talouza village until 01:55. • Detention: At 14:20 on July 18th 2014, Israeli forces detained Abdel Hakim Assi (14 years old) (A resident of Balata camp) near "Barcha" settlement located in south Nablus. • Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces positioned near "Elon Mora" settlement located in east Azmot village, which is located in east Nablus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to Olive trees owned by Ayed Hussien (A resident of Deir Al-Hatab village). (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to tw9 detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Settler Violence: At 01:20, Israeli settlers positioned at "Kafar Tubah" settlement junction assaulted several residents as they were passing the area in their vehicles. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.

exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village.

- (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' until 20:00.
- (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 01:40.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 12:30.
- (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Ush Al-Ghurab area located in Beit Sahur as they escorted several Israeli settlers.
- (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed several homes and detained two residents including a child.
