All Districts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On July 20th 2014, President of the State of Palestine Mahmoud Abbas declared 3 days of mourning in memory of the 72 civilians killed by Israeli forces in Al-Shuja'iya neighbourhood in Gaza city for all Governmental Institutions in the country and abroad. Also a District wide strike closing all shops in protest of the Israeli Assault on the Gaza strip.
JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Biddu and Sur Bahar village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident.
 - (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents: Marwan Al-Zaban, Bader Dar Hattab, Ammar Badran, Mohammad Al-Eish and Sami Al-Haj Ali.
 - (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ijza village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (vi) At 00:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiya village, Al-Tur and Al-Suwana neighbourhoods fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Killing:** Israeli forces killed Mohammad Al-Shumari (A resident of Al-Ram) near Al-Ram junction.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) On July 20th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Da’is (A resident of Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem).
 - (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata detained two residents including a child: Nimr Abdel-Jawad (13 years old) and Musa Al-Silwadi.
 - (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces detained five residents: Abed Abu Khdeir,

	<p>Mohammad Zakariya Abu Khdeir, Abdel Rahman Abu Khdeir, Mohammad Jasser Abu Khdeir and Mohammad Ali Abu Khdeir in Shu'fat neighbourhood.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge located in North Bir Zeit, temporarily detained Ramadan Arif (A resident of Ajoul village) and released him later then withdrew at 20:00. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located on the road connecting Ramallah and Jericho until 24:00. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a child. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of "Pesagout" settlements located east of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and injured a resident. (iv) At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Bet El" settlement junction located in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents. • Detention: Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp detained Raed Ibrahim. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, stormed Ali Abu Shimaleh and

	<p>converted it into a Military post then withdrew at 00:10.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin temporarily detained Mao'yad Samarah (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 17:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near "Evni Heves" settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 21:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 00:15. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Shufa and Izbit Shufa until 01:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:20, Israeli forces served order for nine families preventing them from leave their homes located near the wall gate in Nazlat Issa village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate near Nazlat Issa village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several home and residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:40, Israeli forces raided immatin village, stormed and searched several homes, detained 5 residents including a National Security Force officer and a University student then released them at 08:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained five residents: Yahya Suwan (a National Security Force officer), Mohammad Ghannam, Jawad Biri, Anas Ghannam and Hussien Biri in Immatin village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of

	<p>Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 02:20. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osirin village until 02:10. • Raid: At 02:55, Israeli forces raided the east neighbourhoods of Nablus and Askar camp, clashed with several residents and as a result injured five residents and detained three others in Askar camp then withdrew at 04:15. • Detention: Israeli forces detained three residents: Fadil Abu Salim, Wadah Aliyan and Na'im Qandil in Askar camp. • Attack: At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint, the entrance of Beita and Madma, Burin and Qusra villages fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents. • Injuries: On the evening of July 20th 2014, 5 residents including three children were injured during clashes with Israeli forces at Huwara checkpoint: Ahmad Suliman (13 years old), Nabil Musa (16 years old), Hussam Sabah (17 years old), Mohammad Al-Madani and Taleb U'quba. • Physical Assault: At 02:55, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint assaulted and injured Mohammad Shihadeh (A resident of Orif village) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • Settler Violence: At 02:55, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Tur area in Nablus and attacked Mohammad Abu Hussiens home then withdrew at 03:55.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 00:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 02:10. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut until 21:30. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village in Beit Sahur, near Al-Khader and at the entrance of Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
